

## RETURNING TO ORDINARY LIFE

Six weeks into our Easter rejoicing, the Church gives us readings today that start preparing us for a return to ordinary life. The Acts of the Apostles and the Gospel both dwell on proper daily behavior for followers of Jesus, while the reading from Revelation reminds us why we bother with laws at all. In Acts, leaders of the church meet to discuss which essential elements of the Mosaic Law converts must obey if they wish to be disciples of Jesus Christ. John's Gospel reflects back to the Last Supper discourse when Jesus himself emphasizes the importance of obeying God's commandments. Observing God's law, says Jesus, shows a desire to be intimate with the Lord. We follow rules not for their own sake, but to love God and neighbor better. ## VOLVER A LA VIDA ORDINARIA

Seis semanas después de la celebración de la Pascua, la Iglesia nos da las lecturas de hoy que empiezan a prepararnos para regresar a la vida ordinaria. Tanto las del libro de los Hechos de los Apóstoles como el Evangelio se fijan en el comportamiento cotidiano de los seguidores de Jesús, mientras que la lectura del Apocalipsis nos recuerda por qué nos agobiamos por las leyes. En los Hechos, los líderes de la Iglesia se reúnen para comentar qué elementos esenciales de la Ley de Moisés deben obedecer los conversos si desean ser discípulos de Jesucristo. El Evangelio de Juan se remota al discurso de la Última Cena, cuando el propio Jesús subraya la importancia de obedecer los mandamientos de Dios. Observar la ley de Dios, dice Jesús, muestra el deseo de intimar con el Señor. Seguimos las normas no por sí mismas, sino para amar mejor a Dios y al prójimo. **PASTOR'S MESSAGE —Fr. Matthew Cormier****THE MONTH OF MARY**

During the month of May, the Church has the ancient tradition of paying special honor to the Mother of God. There is the custom in many places of holding "May Crownings". Most of the month of May usually falls during the Easter Season. So, we are honoring the Mother of God while simultaneously rejoicing in the resurrection of her Son. We cannot even begin to imagine the joy in her heart when Jesus rose from the dead. In our Catholic tradition, there is a prayer that seeks to recall that joy. It is the *Regina Caeli*. Many of you are no doubt familiar with the Angelus Prayer. When church bells ring at 6 in the morning, at noon, and again at 6 in the evening, those are called the Angelus bells. It is a call to prayer to stop and pray, recalling the moment of the Incarnation, the moment when Mary gave her yes, her *fiat* to the angel and the Word became flesh and dwelt among us. In many parishes, this prayer is prayed either before or after Mass especially if it is around one of those traditional hours. There is the custom of the popes praying the angelus with the crowds in St. Peter's Square at noon on Sundays and Holy Days.

But during the fifty days of the Easter Season, the Angelus is replaced with another Marian anthem, the *Regina Caeli*.

*Queen of heaven, rejoice, alleluia.  
The Son whom you merited to bear, alleluia.  
Has risen as he said, alleluia.  
Pray for us to God, alleluia.  
Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia.  
Because the Lord is truly risen, alleluia.*

In moments of grief, fear, and uncertainty, let us take comfort and rejoice with Mary that her Son is truly risen. It is a prayer of hope, a reminder that this life is passing and that there is something beyond this world. It is in those periods of trial that we can be purified. It is in those hours of darkness, when God seems silent, that He is in fact closest to us. Believing in the resurrection means that we can have joyful hearts even in the midst of the deepest sorrows. Therefore, let us invoke the prayer and the anthem as we rejoice with our Queen.

**MENSAJE DEL PARROCO— P. Matthew Cormier****EL MES DE MARIA**

Durante el mes de Mayo, la Iglesia tiene la antigua tradición de rendir un homenaje especial a la Madre de Dios. Existe la costumbre en muchos lugares de celebrar "las Coronaciones de Mayo". La mayor parte del mes de mayo usualmente cae durante la temporada de la Semana Santa. Así, estamos honrando a la Madre de Dios, y así simultáneamente, regocijándonos en la resurrección de su Hijo. Ni siquiera podemos imaginar la alegría en su corazón cuando Jesús resucitó de entre los muertos. En nuestra tradición católica, hay una oración que busca recordar esa alegría. Es el *Regina Caeli*. Muchos de ustedes están sin duda familiarizados con la Oración del Angelus. Cuando las campanas de la Iglesia suenan a las 6 de la mañana, al mediodía, y de nuevo a las 6 de la tarde, se llaman las campanas Angelus. Es un llamado a la oración para detenerse y orar, recordando el momento de la encarnación, el momento en que María dio el sí, su Fátal al Ángel y la Palabra se convirtió en carne y habitó entre nosotros. En muchas Parroquias, esta oración se oraba antes o después de la Misa, especialmente si era alrededor de una de esas horas tradicionales. Existe la costumbre de los papas orando el Angelus con las multitudes en la Plaza de San Pedro los Domingos al mediodía y los Días Santos.

Pero durante los 50 días de la temporada de Pascua, el Angelus es sustituido por otro himno Mariano, el *Regina Caeli*.

*Reina del cielo, Alégrate, Aleluya.  
El Hijo a quien merecías llevar, Aleluya.  
Ha resucitado como Él dijo, Aleluya.  
Ruega por nosotros a Dios, Aleluya.  
Regocijas y alegrías, oh Virgen María, Aleluya.  
Porque el Señor ha verdaderamente resucitado, Aleluya.*

En momentos de aflicción, miedo e incertidumbre, tengamos consuelo y regocijémonos con María de que su Hijo ha verdaderamente resucitado. Es una oración de esperanza, un recordatorio de que esta vida está pasando y que hay algo más allá de este mundo. Es en esos períodos de prueba que podemos ser purificados. Es en esas horas de oscuridad, cuando Dios parece silencioso, que Él es de hecho el más cercano a nosotros. Creer en la resurrección significa que podemos tener corazones gozosos incluso en medio de los más profundos dolores. Por tanto, invoquemos una oración y el himno mientras nos regocijamos con nuestra Reina.

Quia quem meruisti portare, alleluia.  
Resurrexit, sicut dixit, alleluia.  
Ora pro nobis Deum, alleluia.  
Gaude et laetare, Virgo Maria, Alleluia.




