FAITH

Our readings today explore how faith begins and how faith works. Faith begins with God's initiative of love, together with God's promise about the future. The passage from Hebrews urges readers to have an assured confidence in God, who promised and delivered a lasting legacy to Abraham. The book of Wisdom reminds readers of the God who promised and delivered freedom from slavery during the Exodus. In the Gospel passage from Luke, Jesus begins with the promise that "your Father is pleased to give you the Kingdom," before describing how to live faithfully during times when God seems absent. God's promises mean that God is fully invested in our future. Living in these promises, we can confidently let go of fear and insecurity. We can anticipate that when God intervenes in our lives, it will be for our benefit. And we can become God's partners in fulfilling these divine promises.

En el pasaje del Evangelio de Lucas, Jesús comenzó con la promesa que "su Padre se alegra en darles el Reino", antes de describir cómo vivir con fidelidad en momentos cuando Dios parece ausente. Las promesas de Dios significan que Dios está plenamente implicado en nuestro futuro. Viviendo en estas promesas, podemos confiadamente dejar de lado el miedo y la inseguridad. Podemos anticipar que cuando Dios interviene en nuestras vidas, será para nuestro beneficio. Y podemos convertirnos en colaboradores de Dios en el cumplimiento de estas promesas divinas.



**NEW CHURCH SECURITY PROTOCOL
BEGINNING WEEKEND OF SEPTEMBER 11TH**

As you entered the church today, you may have noticed something different about the doors. There are now “push-bars” at all the exits. A push-bar allows one to exit the building even when the door is locked. Why do we now have this? More than four years ago, when Fr. Starkovich was the pastor, a discussion was begun with the Pastoral and Finance Councils about security during weekend Masses. When I became Pastor, I continued that discussion and asked for all parishioners who are in law enforcement to contact me, and we held a meeting. Their recommendations were presented to the Pastoral and Finance Councils and in 2019, we agreed to a plan of action that included the presence of off-duty officers at as many weekend Masses as possible and the purchase and installation of push-bars on the doors. Due to the pandemic lockdowns and storms, the purchase and installation of the push-bars was put on hold.

As the Pastor, this is something that I have prayed about, considered, and consulted on for four years. It is not something that any pastor ever wants to do. We want the church to be as inviting as possible. However, given the rise in violent crime and the increasing number of violent attacks on Catholic churches in the wake of the overturning of Roe v. Wade, the time has come to put in place the plan that was created three years ago to help keep everyone safe who comes to worship here. While the Lord does not want us to ever be afraid, He also wants us to exercise the virtue of prudence.

Here is what you need to know:

THE FOLLOWING SECURITY PROTOCOL WILL BE OBSERVED AT ALL WEEKEND MASSES BEGINNING THE WEEKEND OF SEPTEMBER 11, 2022.

(This date was chosen to give us time to prepare everyone and to provide a start date that is easy to remember as it is also the first Sunday after Labor Day and the first day of CCD.)

1. ONCE MASS BEGINS, THE DOORS OF THE CHURCH WILL BE LOCKED.
2. AFTER MASS BEGINS, THE ONLY WAY TO ENTER THE CHURCH WILL BE THROUGH THE FRONT DOORS ON THE WEST SIDE (8th Avenue) WHERE A SECURITY PERSON WILL BE STATIONED.
3. BECAUSE OF THE PUSH-BARS, YOU CAN ALWAYS EXIT FROM THE INSIDE. YOU JUST CANNOT COME BACK IN WHEN THE DOORS ARE LOCKED. IF YOU HAVE TO GO OUTSIDE DURING MASS FOR ANY REASON, YOU WILL ONLY BE ABLE TO REENTER THE CHURCH THROUGH THE FRONT DOORS.

What are some things we can all do to make this process go smoothly and keep the Sacred Liturgy as reverent and prayerful as possible?

1. Don't be late. This is just one more reason to make the extra effort to get to Mass early and spend some time in prayer before Mass begins.
2. Children should never be left outside or sent outside the church without an adult.
3. If you are late or have to go outside through the north or south entrance during Mass, do **not** knock on the door asking to be let back in. Go to the front doors.
4. For those inside the church, do not open a locked door if you cannot see who is on the other side.

PASTOR'S MESSAGE — Matthew Cormier

NUEVO PROTOCOLO DE SEGURIDAD DE LA IGLESIA A PARTIR DEL 11 DE SEPTIEMBRE

Al entrar en la iglesia hoy, es posible que hayan notado algo diferente acerca de las puertas. Ahora hay “barras de empuje” en todas las salidas. Una barra de empuje permite salir del edificio incluso cuando la puerta está cerrada. ¿Por qué ahora tenemos esto? Hace más de cuatro años, cuando el Padre Starkovich era el párroco, se inició una discusión con los Consejos Pastorales y Financieros sobre la seguridad durante las misas del fin de semana. Cuando me convertí en párroco, continué esa discusión y pedí que todos los feligreses que están en diligencia con la ley que se pusieran en contacto conmigo, y realizamos una reunión. Sus recomendaciones fueron presentadas a los Consejos Pastoral y de Finanzas y en el 2019, acordamos un plan de acción que incluía la presencia de oficiales fuera de servicio en tantas misas de fin de semana como fuera posible y la compra e instalación de barras de empuje en las puertas. Debido a los cierres pandémicos y tormentas, la compra e instalación de las barras de empuje se suspendieron.

Como párroco, esto es algo por lo que he orado, considerado y consultado durante cuatro años. No es algo que ningún párroco quiera hacer. Queremos que la iglesia sea lo más atractiva posible. Sin embargo, dado el aumento de los delitos violentos y el creciente número de ataques violentos contra las iglesias católicas a raíz de la anulación de Roe v. Wade, ha llegado el momento de poner en marcha el plan que se hizo hace tres años para ayudar a mantener a salvo a todos los que vienen a adorar aquí. Aunque que el Señor no quiere que nunca tengamos miedo, El también quiere que ejercitemos la virtud de la prudencia.

Esto es lo que necesitan saber:

EL SIGUIENTE PROTOCOLO DE SEGURIDAD SE OBSERVARÁ EN TODAS LAS MISAS DE FIN DE SEMANA A PARTIR DEL FIN DE SEMANA DEL 11 DE SEPTIEMBRE DEL 2022.

(Esta fecha fue elegida para darnos tiempo para preparar a todos y para proporcionar una fecha de inicio que sea fácil de recordar, ya que también es el primer domingo después del Día del Trabajo y el primer día de clases del CCD.)

1. UNA VEZ QUE COMIENZE LA MISA, LAS PUERTAS DE LA IGLESIA ESTARÁN CERRADAS.
2. DESPUÉS DE QUE COMIENZE LA MISA, LA ÚNICA FORMA DE INGRESAR A LA IGLESIA SERÁ A TRAVÉS DE LAS PUERTAS PRINCIPALES EN EL LADO OESTE (8^a AVENIDA) DONDE SE ESTACIONARÁ UNA PERSONA DE SEGURIDAD.
3. DEBIDO A QUE, CON LAS BARRAS DE EMPUJE, SIEMPRE PUEDEN SALIR POR EL INTERIOR. SIMPLEMENTE NO PUEDEN VOLVER A ENTRAR CUANDO LAS PUERTAS ESTÁN CERRADAS. SI TIENE QUE SALIR DURANTE LA MISA POR CUALQUIER MOTIVO, SOLO PODRÁ VOLVER A INGRESAR A LA IGLESIA POR LAS PUERTAS PRINCIPALES.

¿Cuáles son algunas de las cosas que todos podemos hacer para que este proceso transcurra sin problemas y mantenga la Sagrada Liturgia lo más reverente y orante posible?

- 1) No lleguen tarde. Esta es solo una razón más para hacer el esfuerzo adicional de llegar temprano a la Misa y pasar algún tiempo en oración antes de que comience la Misa.
- 2) Los niños nunca deben ser dejados afuera o enviados fuera de la iglesia sin un adulto.
- 3) Si llega tarde o tiene que salir a la calle por la salida norte o sur durante la Misa, **no** toque la puerta pidiendo que le dejen entrar. Vaya a las puertas del frente.
- 4) Para aquellos dentro de la iglesia, no abran una puerta cerrada si no pueden ver quién está del otro lado.


Prayer for Safety in Hurricane Season


