## CONFIAR EN EL AMOR DE DIOS



## PAROCHIAL VICAR'S MESSAGE — FR. JOSEPH CARAWAY

**St. Peter Claver**

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has decided to do a National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in the Summer of 2024. Prior to this congress, there will be many diocesan level activities to prepare the people for this congress. This will involve prayer services, conferences, processions, etc. The first of these diocesan events will involve a Daytime prayer service on the Diocesan Patron Feast Day of St. Peter Claver on Sunday, **September 11, 2022 at 2:30 p.m. at Our Lady Queen of Heaven.** This is open to the public and all are invited. In preparation for this event, the diocese has given us some history on St. Peter Claver that I have shared below.

**History of Saint Peter Claver**

*Saint Peter Claver was born in Barcelona in modern day Spain in 1580. He joined the Society of Jesus, commonly called the Jesuits. After being influenced by Saint Alphonsus Rodriguez, Peter Claver decided he wanted to be a missionary to what was then known as “The New World”.*

*To that end, he continued his studies and was sent to the then called “New Granada” or modern-day Colombia and was ordained at Cartagena in 1615. Cartagena was the principal center of the African slave trade and Peter Claver spent his life trying to alleviate the horrible conditions of the slaves. He worked among the slaves in the yards where they were penned and ministered to them with food and medicine. He was able to baptize some three thousand persons over his 40 years of ministry. However, his ministry did not just concern the souls of these unfortunates.*

*Peter Claver would visit the plantations and plead with owners of these slaves to improve their conditions of life and work. During these visits, he lodged with the slaves. In addition to his ministry to the slaves, Peter Claver visited the imprisoned and the lepers. He was known as a great preacher and led a very austere life; he is reputed to have possessed supernatural gifts including that of prophecy, miracles, and the ability to read the hearts and minds of people.*

*In 1650, he was stricken with a plague that beset Cartagena but he did not neglect his duties even when mortally ill. He died on September 8 and was canonized in 1888. Pope Leo XIII named him the patron of all missionary activities to African-Americans. His feast day is September 9.*

*Since Bishop Speyrer's choice of Peter Claver as Diocesan Patron, his feast is observed on the Sunday nearest to the actual feast day, thus allowing more of the faithful to attend and participate.*

## MENSAJE DEL VICARIO PARROQUIAL—P. JOSEPH CARAWAY

**San Pedro Claver**

La Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB) ha decidido realizar un Congreso Eucarístico Nacional en Indianápolis en el verano del 2024. Antes de este congreso, habrán muchas actividades a nivel diocesano para preparar a la gente para este congreso. Esto involucrará servicios de oración, conferencias, procesiones, etc. El primero de estos eventos diocesanos involucrará un servicio de oración durante el Día de la Fiesta del Patrón Diocesano de San Pedro Claver el domingo, 11 de septiembre del 2022 a las 2:30 p.m. en **Our Lady Queen of Heaven.** Esto está abierto al público y todos están invitados. En preparación para este evento, la diócesis nos ha dado un poco de historia sobre San Pedro Claver que he compartido a continuación.

**Historia de San Pedro Claver**

*San Pedro Claver nació en Barcelona en la actual España en 1580. Se unió a la Compañía de Jesús, comúnmente llamada los Jesuitas. Después de ser influenciado por San Alfonso Rodríguez, Peter Claver decidió que quería ser misionero de lo que entonces se conocía como “el Nuevo Mundo”.*

*Con ese fin, continuó sus estudios y fue enviado a la entonces llamada “Nueva Granada” o Colombia moderna y fue ordenado en Cartagena en 1615. Cartagena era el centro principal del comercio de esclavos africanos y Peter Claver pasó su vida tratando de aliviar las horribles condiciones de los esclavos. Él trabajó entre los esclavos en los patios donde ellos fueron esclupidos y ministrados a ellos con comida y medicina. Fue capaz de bautizar a unas tres mil personas durante sus 40 años de ministerio. Sin embargo, su ministerio no sólo se refería a las almas de estos infelizados.*

*Pedro Claver visitaba las plantaciones y suplicaba a los propietarios de estos esclavos que mejoraran sus condiciones de vida y trabajo. Durante estas visitas, se alojó con los esclavos. Además de su ministerio a los esclavos, Pedro Claver visitó a los presos y a los leprosos. Fue conocido como un gran predicador y llevó una vida muy austera; se le reputa haber poseído dones sobrenaturales incluyendo la profecía, los milagros, y la habilidad de leer corazones y mente de las personas.*

*En 1650, fue golpeado con una plaga que acosó Cartagena pero no descuidó sus deberes incluso cuando estaba mortalmente enfermo. Murió el 8 de septiembre y fue canonizado en 1888. El Papa León XIII lo nombró patrono de todas las actividades misioneras a los afroamericanos. Su día de fiesta es el 9 de septiembre.*

*Desde que el obispo Speyrer eligió Pedro Claver como patrón diocesano, su fiesta se observa el domingo más cercano al día de la fiesta real, lo que permite que más fieles asistan y participen.*
