The Eucharist in the Lives of the Saints

Every saint in history has a connection to the Holy Eucharist and we can learn more about the Eucharist from each one. Today, I would like to share the story of St. Hermengild and his devotion to the true presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Despite the trials he faced, he remained faithful to the Eucharist.

St. Hermengild lived in the late sixth century and his father, Leovigild, was an Arian king of the Visigoths. The Arians were a heretical group that did not believe in the Church's teachings on Christ's divinity. St. Hermengild's was raised in this heretical household until he married Ingundis who was a Catholic princess from Germany. St. Hermengild decided to renounce the Arian teaching and enter the Catholic Church, but his parents were outraged by this decision. Eventually, Leovigild would capture his son and put him in prison to try and force him back to the Arian beliefs. Leovigild decided that he would forgive his son for all his supposed crimes if he received Communion from an Arian Bishop. St. Hermengild refused to receive Communion from the hands of the Arian Bishop because he refused to reject his Catholic faith. Ultimately, his act of faithfulness to Holy Communion in the Catholic Church cost him his life.

The Holy Eucharist in the Sacrifice of the Mass is something that is sacred and precious. We are willing to give our lives to protect it and this requires courage like St. Hermengild. It would have been easy to save his physical life and receive communion from the Arian bishop, but he refused to deny his faith. Therefore, he is honored as a saint. The saints did not have easy or glorious lives, but they did live lives of faithfulness. The saints believed in the authority of the Holy Catholic Church and the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. When we receive Holy Communion, it is a public act that we do as a whole congregation to enter a union with the entire Catholic Church on earth and in heaven. This expresses that we all believe with our whole being, body and soul, in the teachings of the Catholic Church and the true presence in the Eucharist.

La Eucaristía en la Vida de los Santos

Cada santo en la historia tiene una conexión con la Sagrada Eucaristía y podemos aprender más sobre la Eucaristía de cada uno. Hoy, me gustaría compartir la historia de San Hermengild y su devoción a la verdadera presencia de Jesucristo en la Eucaristía. A pesar de las pruebas que enfrentó, permaneció fiel a la Eucaristía.

San Hermengild vivió a finales del siglo VI y su padre, Leovigild, era un rey Arriano de los Visigodos. Los Arrianos eran un grupo herético que no creía en las enseñanzas de la Iglesia sobre la divinidad de Cristo. San Hermengild se crió en esta casa herética hasta que se casó con Ingundis, que era una princesa católica de Alemania. San Hermengild decidió renunciar a la enseñanza arriana y entrar en la Iglesia Católica, pero sus padres se indignaron por esta decisión. Eventualmente, Leovigild capturaría a su hijo y lo pondría en prisión para tratar de forzarlo de nuevo a las creencias arrianas. Leovigild decidió que perdonaría a su hijo por todos sus supuestos crímenes si recibiera la Comunión de y del Obispo Arian. San Hermengild se negó a recibir la Comunión de manos del Obispo Arriano porque se negó a rechazar su fe católica. Finalmente, su acto de fidelidad a la Santa Comunión en la Iglesia Católica le costó la vida.

La Sagrada Eucaristía en el sacrificio de la Misa es algo sagrado y precioso. Estamos dispuestos a dar nuestras vidas para protegerla y esto requiere coraje como San Hermengild. Hubiera sido fácil salvar su vida física y recibir la comunión del obispo arriano, pero él se negó a negar su fe. Por lo tanto, es honrado como santo. Los santos no tuvieron vidas fáciles o gloriosas, pero sí vivieron vidas de fidelidad. Los santos creían en la autoridad de la Santa Iglesia Católica y el sagrado sacrificio de la Misa. Cuando recibimos la Santa Comunión, es un acto público que hacemos como una congregación entera para entrar en una unión con toda la Iglesia Católica en la tierra y en el cielo. Esto expresa que todos creemos con todo nuestro ser, cuerpo y alma, en las enseñanzas de la Iglesia Católica y en la verdadera presencia en la Eucaristía.


VOCATION PRAYER




