Clergy Corner

LENTEN PENANCE NIGHT

Wednesday March 29th

5:00-7:00pm in all churches of North Central Deanery

(St. Henry [Spanish available], Immaculate Conception Cathedral, St. Margaret, St. Theodore, Immaculate Heart of Mary, Sacred Heart of Jesus, St. Raphael) Here at St. Henry's, four priests will be available for those two hours (2 English, 2 Spanish).

If you have been away from Confession, here are what the saints have to say.

"The confession of evil works is the first beginning of good works." (St. Augustine)

"In the life of the body a man is sometimes sick, and unless he takes medicine, he will die. Even so in the spiritual life a man is sick on account of sin. For that reason he needs medicine so that he may be restored to health; and this grace is bestowed in the Sacrament of Penance." (St. Thomas Aquinas)

"Don't worry if it's been a while since you've gone to confession—God is waiting to meet you there. Don't settle for ashes alone when you can receive absolution and a fresh start!" (St. Teresa of Calcutta)

"Confession is an act of honesty and courage – an act of entrusting ourselves, beyond sin, to the mercy of a loving and forgiving God" (St. John Paul II).

Here are some basic do's and don'ts of confessing.

Do tell the priest how long it has been since your last confession.

Do confess all the mortal sins you remember and the approximate number of times you committed them. If it has been a long time and you are not sure of the exact number, then give the priest a general idea of the frequency of such sins. Was it a one time fall? Does it happen occasionally? Is it an ongoing habit or addiction? Confession of venial sins is encouraged, but not strictly necessary.

Do be brief. Be mindful that other people may be waiting in line behind you. It's not time for a conversation. If you need to talk to the priest about a separate matter or you need more in depth counseling or spiritual direction, please talk to the priest outside of the sacrament.

Do say what needs to be said. While not going into every little detail, say enough so that the priest understands the nature of the sin. Name your sins. There is no need to be ashamed or afraid. The priest has heard it all. You are not going to shock him. Ask yourself, if you were sitting on the other side of the screen, would you understand the sin you were confessing?

Do conclude your confession by saying "for these and for all my sins I am truly sorry".

Do not intentionally omit any mortal sins. We cannot hide anything from God. "If the sick person is too ashamed to show his wound to the doctor, the medicine cannot heal what it does not know". If you honestly forgot to mention a sin, rest assured it is forgiven. If you remember it later, just confess it at your next confession.

Do not make excuses or "pass the buck". Take responsibility for your actions. "Through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault".

Do not confess other people's sins. Stick to what YOU did, not what your spouse, your family members, or coworkers did.

NOCHE DE PENITENCIA CUARESMA

Miércoles 29 de marzo

5:00-7:00pm en todas las iglesias del Decanato Central Norte

(San Henry, Catedral de la Inmaculada Concepción, Santa Margaret, San Teodoro, Inmaculado Corazón de María, Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, San Rafael). Aquí en San Henry, cuatro sacerdotes estarán disponibles para esas dos horas (2 en inglés, 2 en español).

Si has estado lejos de la confesión, esto es lo que los santos tienen que decir.

"La confesión de las malas obras es el primer comienzo de las buenas obras." (San Agustín)

"En la vida del cuerpo, un hombre a veces está enfermo, y a menos que tome medicamentos, morirá. Aun así, en la vida espiritual, un hombre está enfermo a causa del pecado. Por esa razón necesita medicamentos para que pueda recuperar la salud; y esta gracia se otorga en el sacramento de la Penitencia." (Santo Tomás de Aquino)

"No te preocupes si ha pasado un tiempo desde que te confesaste, Dios está esperando encontrarte allí. ¡No te conformes con las cenizas solo cuando puedas recibir la absolución y un nuevo comienzo!" (Santa Teresa de Calcuta)

"La confesión es un acto de honestidad y valentía, un acto de confiarnos, más allá del pecado, a la misericordia de un Dios que ama y perdona" (San Juan Pablo II).

Aquí hay algunas cosas básicas que se deben y no se deben hacer en la confesión.

Dígale al sacerdote cuánto tiempo ha pasado desde su última confesión.

Confiese todos los pecados mortales que recuerde y el número aproximado de veces que lo cometió. Si ha pasado mucho tiempo y no está seguro del número exacto, entonces dele al sacerdote una idea general de la frecuencia de tales pecados. ¿Fue una única caída? ¿Sucede ocasionalmente? ¿Es un hábito o adicción continua? La confesión de los pecados veniales es alentada, pero no estrictamente necesaria.

Sea breve. Tenga en cuenta que otras personas pueden estar esperando en la fila detrás de usted. No es hora de una conversación. Si necesita hablar con el sacerdote sobre un asunto separado o necesita asesoramiento más profundo o dirección espiritual, hable con el sacerdote fuera del sacramento.

Diga lo que hay que decir. Sin entrar en cada pequeño detalle, diga lo suficiente para que el sacerdote entienda la naturaleza del pecado. Nombre sus pecados. No hay necesidad de avergonzarse o tener miedo. El sacerdote lo ha escuchado todo. No lo van a sorprender. Pregúntese, si estuviera sentado al otro lado de la pantalla, ¿entendería el pecado que está confesando?

Concluya su confesión diciendo "por estos y por todos mis pecados estoy verdaderamente arrepentido".

No omita intencionalmente ningún pecado mortal. No podemos esconder nada de Dios. "Si la persona enferma está demasiado avergonzada para mostrar su herida al médico, la medicina no puede curar lo que no sabe". Si honestamente olvido mencionar un pecado, tenga la seguridad de que es perdonado. Si lo recuerda más tarde, simplemente confíeselo en su próxima confesión.

No ponga excusas ni "pase la pelota". Asuma la responsabilidad de sus acciones. "Por mi culpa, por mi culpa, por mi gran culpa".

No confiese los pecados de otras personas. Apéguese a lo que USTED hizo, no a lo que hizo su cónyuge, los miembros de su familia o sus compañeros de trabajo.

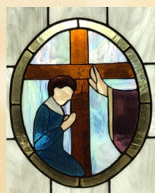
