

Clergy Corner

Holy Week

Now that we have celebrated Palm Sunday, we focus our attention on Holy Week. As Catholics, we know this is the highest and most solemn celebration of our faith and it deserves special attention. It requires special attention because it includes the Triduum celebration of, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday. The most common term to refer to all these celebrations is "Holy Week." However, saints like John Chrysostom called it the "great week." It was "great" because of the great mystery that the Church is celebrating. It was also referred to as the "painful week," on account of the sufferings that Our Lord endured and the fatigue required to celebrate it. It was also called the "week of indulgence," because sinners are to receive penance before entering the season of Easter.

The names, "painful week" and "week of indulgence" convey the idea that fasting is increased during this last week. This is the time that the faithful increase their energy of spiritual and physical penance to enter the mystery with Christ instead of observing it. It is tempting to ease off prayer, fasting, and alms giving during this time, but increasing them will help a person grow in their love and faith in Christ.

When Christ washed the apostles' feet on Holy Thursday, he is increasing their love and faith. He is not only increasing their love and faith by the act of washing their feet, but also establishing his priests for the world. He is humbly giving himself to the world through his apostles so they can give Christ to all. This act of washing the disciples' feet is a ceremonial washing from the Old Testament to establish the priesthood, and Jesus is establishing the priest of the new covenant to give the Eucharist, his body and blood. This night is a reminder to all of us that he has given us the Eucharist to increase our faith and love in him. After we are reminded of the institution of the Eucharist through the sacrifice of the Mass through Jesus' priesthood, we enter Good Friday.

Good Friday is where we enter the passion of Christ when he died on the cross and is placed in the tomb. Not only do we unite ourselves physically by intense fasting, but the entire Church also endures a spiritual fast because Good Friday is the only day of the year that the Holy Mass is not celebrated. Thus, we enter a physical and spiritual fast with the Church to be united in the mystery she celebrates. Our eyes are fixed on the passion of Christ this day and builds anticipation to the resurrection of Christ at the Easter Vigil. It is there that the Holy Mass returns in its highest form of solemnity.

In summary, Holy Week is a solemn time for Catholics and it's a special time to enter the great mystery, but to enter that mystery, we must place ourselves in the passion of Christ. I encourage everyone to make Good Friday a true day of penance and to remain faithful to your Lenten promises until after the Easter Vigil. This will bring about a greater celebration and joy with our Lord on the day of his resurrection.

Semana Santa

Ahora que hemos celebrado el Domingo de Ramos, centramos nuestra atención en la Semana Santa. Como católicos, sabemos que esta es la celebración más grande y solemne de nuestra fe y merece una atención especial. Requiere atención especial porque incluye la celebración del Triduo del Jueves Santo, el Viernes Santo y el Domingo de Pascua. El término más común para referirse a todas estas celebraciones es "Semana Santa". Sin embargo, santos como Juan Crisóstomo la llamaron la "gran semana". Fue "grande" por el gran misterio que la Iglesia está celebrando. También se la conocía como la "semana dolorosa", debido a los sufrimientos que Nuestro Señor soportó y la fatiga requerida para celebrarla. También fue llamada la "semana de la indulgencia", porque los pecadores deben recibir penitencia antes de entrar en la temporada de Pascua.

Los nombres, "semana dolorosa" y "semana de indulgencia" transmiten la idea de que el ayuno aumenta durante esta última semana. Este es el momento en que los fieles aumentan su energía de penitencia espiritual y física para entrar en el misterio con Cristo en lugar de observarlo. Es tentador dejar la oración, el ayuno y la limosna durante este tiempo, pero aumentarlos ayudará a una persona a crecer en su amor y fe en Cristo.

Cuando Cristo lava los pies de los apóstoles el Jueves Santo, está aumentando su amor y fe. Él no sólo está aumentando su amor y fe por el acto de lavar sus pies, sino también estableciendo a sus sacerdotes para el mundo. Él se está entregando humildemente al mundo a través de sus apóstoles para que puedan dar a Cristo a todos. Este acto de lavar los pies de los discípulos es un lavado ceremonial del Antiguo Testamento para establecer el sacerdocio, y Jesús está estableciendo al sacerdote del nuevo pacto para dar la Eucaristía, su cuerpo y sangre. Esta noche es un recordatorio para todos nosotros de que nos ha dado la Eucaristía para aumentar nuestra fe y amor en él. Después de recordar la institución de la Eucaristía a través del sacrificio de la Misa a través del sacerdocio de Jesús, entramos en el Viernes Santo.

El Viernes Santo es donde entramos en la pasión de Cristo cuando murió en la cruz y es colocado en la tumba. No solo nos unimos físicamente por un ayuno intenso, sino que toda la Iglesia también soporta un ayuno espiritual porque el Viernes Santo es el único día del año en que no se celebra la Santa Misa. Así, entramos en un ayuno físico y espiritual con la Iglesia para estar unidos en el misterio que ella celebra. Nuestros ojos están fijos en la pasión de Cristo este día y construyen anticipación a la resurrección de Cristo en la Vigilia Pascual. Es allí donde la Santa Misa regresa en su forma más alta de solemnidad.

En resumen, la Semana Santa es un tiempo solemne para los católicos y es un momento especial para entrar en el gran misterio, pero para entrar en ese misterio, debemos colocarnos en la pasión de Cristo. Animo a todos a hacer del Viernes Santo el verdadero día de penitencia y a permanecer fieles a sus promesas cuaresmales hasta después de la Vigilia Pascual. Esto traerá una mayor celebración y alegría con nuestro Señor en el día de su resurrección.


