Clergy Corner

PASTOR'S EASTER MESSAGE

"We are an Easter people and Alleluia is our song!" (St. John Paul II)

For forty days, the Church has refrained from saying or singing the "A word". During Lent, the usual Gospel acclamation is replaced. No hymns, chants, or prayers that include the word "Alleluia" are permitted. During the forty days of Lent, the Church, like Moses and the Israelites, has wandered through the desert. The time in the desert was a time of penance and purification where, in the words of Psalm 137, "*How shall we sing the Lord's song in a foreign land?*". We went through Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, the agony of Good Friday, and yesterday we watched outside the tomb in silence. Last night, throughout the world, Catholics celebrated the "mother of all vigils", the Easter Vigil in the Holy Night. It is the summit of the liturgical year. In every Cathedral, after the reading of the Epistle and before the Proclamation of the Gospel, a deacon stands before the Bishop, and says, "Most Reverend Father, I bring you a message of great joy, the message of Alleluia." The fast has been broken. The Bishop then intones the triple Alleluia, raising his voice a step each time. Then the entire congregation breaks out singing the Alleluia, as if the walls could not contain their joy.

Alleluia is the song of Easter. Alleluia is the song of the Christian, says John Paul II. The word Alleluia is a transliteration of two Hebrew words meaning "Praise the Lord". In the Old Testament, there is a group of Psalms known as the *Hallel* psalms. These are the psalms that contain the phrase "praise the Lord". The transliteration "Hallelujah" is used in the Book of Revelation as part of the victory hymn of the choirs of angels. Today is the "feast of victory", of Christ's victory over sin and death. Before, death was death. It was definitive. There was no coming back from it. No more.

"We are an Easter people and Alleluia is our song!" said Pope St. John Paul II in an address in Adelaide, Australia in 1986. Before those words he said, "We do not pretend that life is all beauty. We are aware of darkness and sin, poverty and pain. But we know Jesus has conquered sin and passed through his own pain to the glory of the resurrection."

On Good Friday and Holy Saturday, the apostles thought it was the end. Then their faith was restored as Christ stood before them, risen and triumphant. In our lives on this earth, there are times of beauty and joy but also times of darkness and sin, poverty and pain. Times when it seems like all is lost. But that is not true. God can bring good out of the worst evils. Until the moment they draw their last breath, even the worst of sinners has the chance to be saved. Don't forget that the author of half the New Testament, St. Paul, was a mass murderer. From the ashes of sin we can rise, with God's grace. The light of the risen Christ can penetrate the deepest darkness. And even the worst pain on earth will eventually pass.

Let us strive to live up to that title of "Easter people", a people of true joy. Not a shallow superficial joy, but rather a joy that comes from faith...faith in Jesus Christ...faith that He is truly risen. Let Alleluia be our song.
Happy Easter to you and yours from Fr. Cormier and Fr. Caraway.

MENSAJE DE PASCUA DEL PARROCO

"¡Somos un pueblo de Pascua y Aleluya es nuestra canción!" (San Juan Pablo II)

Durante cuarenta días, la Iglesia se ha abstenido de decir o cantar la "Una palabra". Durante la Cuaresma, se reemplaza la aclamación habitual del Evangelio. No se permiten himnos, cantos u oraciones que incluyan la palabra "Aleluya". Durante los cuarenta días de Cuaresma, la Iglesia, como Moisés y los israelitas, ha vagado por el desierto. El tiempo en el desierto fue un tiempo de penitencia y purificación donde, en las palabras del Salmo 137, "*¿Cómo cantaremos la canción del Señor en una tierra extranjera?*". Pasamos por el Domingo de Ramos, el Jueves Santo, la agonía del Viernes Santo, y ayer velamos fuera de la tumba en silencio. Anoche, en todo el mundo, los católicos celebraron la "madre de todas las vigilias", la Vigilia Pascual en la Noche Santa. Es la cumbre del año litúrgico. En cada catedral, después de la lectura de la Epístola y antes de la Proclamación del Evangelio, un diácono se para ante el Obispo y dice: "Reverendísimo Padre, le traigo un mensaje de gran alegría, el mensaje de Aleluya". El ayuno se ha roto. El obispo entonces entona el triple Aleluya, levantando la voz un paso cada vez. Entonces toda la congregación estalla cantando el Aleluya, como si las paredes no pudieran contener su alegría.

El aleluya es la canción de la Pascua. El aleluya es el canto del cristiano, dice Juan Pablo II. La palabra Aleluya es una transliteración de dos palabras hebreas que significan "Alabado sea el Señor". En el Antiguo Testamento, hay un grupo de Salmos conocidos como los salmos Hallel. Estos son los salmos que contienen la frase "alabado sea el Señor". La transliteración "Aleluya" se usa en el Libro de Apocalipsis como parte del himno de victoria de los coros de ángeles. Hoy es la "fiesta de la victoria", de la victoria de Cristo sobre el pecado y la muerte. Antes, la muerte era la muerte. Fue definitivo. No había vuelta atrás. Ya no más.

"¡Somos un pueblo de Pascua y el Aleluya es nuestra canción!", dijo el Papa San Juan Pablo II en un discurso en Adelaide, Australia, en 1986. Antes de esas palabras dijo: "No pretendemos que la vida sea todo belleza. Somos conscientes de la oscuridad y el pecado, la pobreza y el dolor. Pero sabemos que Jesús ha conquistado el pecado y ha pasado a través de su propio dolor a la gloria de la resurrección".

El Viernes Santo y el Sábado Santo, los apóstoles pensaron que era el final. Entonces su fe fue restaurada cuando Cristo estaba delante de ellos, resucitado y triunfante. En nuestras vidas en esta tierra, hay tiempos de belleza y alegría, pero también tiempos de oscuridad y pecado, pobreza y dolor. Momentos en los que parece que todo está perdido. Pero eso no es cierto. Dios puede sacar el bien de los peores males. Hasta el momento en que exhalan su último aliento, incluso el peor de los pecadores tiene la oportunidad de ser salvado. No olvidemos que el autor de la mitad del Nuevo Testamento, San Pablo, fue un asesino en masa. De las cenizas del pecado podemos levantarnos, con la gracia de Dios. La luz de Cristo resucitado puede penetrar en las tinieblas más profundas. E incluso el peor dolor en la tierra eventualmente pasará.

Esforzémonos por estar a la altura de ese título de "pueblo pascual", pueblo de verdadera alegría. No una alegría superficial, sino más bien una alegría que proviene de la fe... fe en Jesucristo... fe en que Él ha resucitado verdaderamente. Que Aleluya sea nuestra canción.

Feliz Pascua a ustedes y a los suyos de parte del Padre Cormier y el Padre Caraway.
