

# Clergy Corner

## NEW CHANCERY OFFICE FOR DIOCESE

In italics below are excerpts from Bishop Provost's May 5 statement announcing the purchase of former Safety Council building for the Administrative Offices of the Diocese of Lake Charles. My comments follow.

*Following extensive consultation beginning August of 2022 with the Presbyteral Council and the Diocesan Finance Council, the Diocese of Lake Charles has decided to consolidate its offices into one location by purchasing a facility, the former Safety Council of Southwest Louisiana located at 1201 Ryan Street. The former Chancery at 414 Iris Street suffered serious damages in Hurricane Laura and Hurricane Delta in 2020. This building remains closed. To continue ministry, the Diocese scattered her offices across five different leased and borrowed facilities. However, the Diocese cannot continue to address the massive work of recovery and continue to operate effectively in disparate locations.*

*After evaluating the available options, the Presbyteral Council, the Finance Council, and I, as Bishop, agree that purchasing an already move-in ready building is the most cost-effective option. Repairing and adapting the current structures would cost at least \$6 million. Replacing with new construction was estimated to cost at least \$15 million. The cost of purchasing the new building and renovating it for our needs will be approximately \$3.3 million, substantially less than the other two options and tripling our available space. No recovery funds allocated to rebuilding parishes or schools will be redirected to the purchase of the new chancery. The Diocese has secured a mortgage for a large portion of the total cost and will finance payments through general operations.*

*Diocesan offices include the following: Administration, Catholic Schools, Tribunal, Family Life, Pro-Life, Marriage, Communications, Religious Education, Fiscal, Vocations, Archives, Youth Protection and Safe Environment, Human Resources, Clergy Immigration, Recovery, and Development.*

*I look upon this as a positive move in the right direction. For the first time in the history of the Diocese, all diocesan offices will be under one roof. This consolidation will advance our ministry and better serve the needs of our people. I am dedicating this new chancery to Our Lady of Lourdes in gratitude for her constant intercession over my 16 years as bishop. As I was praying to her about this decision, I was standing at the grotto located behind the cathedral when I realized that the statue of Our Lady of Lourdes looks down Bilbo Street to the location of our new facility. She has been watching over us this entire time, and I will seek to honor her in a special way so that she watches over both ends of Bilbo Street just as she watches over the entire Church.*

I sit on both the Presbyteral Council and the College of Consultors. In both capacities I voted to approve the purchase. This should say something because you know that I am frustrated with the standstill in the recovery process for us and so many other parishes. Frankly, I think that many of the recovery related decisions made by the Diocese do not make much sense. This decision, however, makes sense. For such an opportunity to present itself in this way can only be the work of Divine Providence.

The only part that I am sad about is that Fr. Joseph Caraway has been appointed as Vice-Chancellor of the Diocese of Lake Charles and in that capacity has been charged with consolidating the many diocesan offices. He is more than capable, and I can see why the Bishop would entrust him with this task. The sad part for St. Henry's is that consolidating the Diocesan offices is a full-time responsibility which does not allow him to have much presence at St. Henry's during the week. He is still technically assigned as Parochial Vicar here for the time-being, but has had to relinquish most of his parish responsibilities (oversight/training of liturgical ministries, youth ministry, Hispanic ministry, marriage prep, annulments, homebound, etc.). Practically speaking, he is "in residence" and assists with Masses. He no longer works out of the St. Henry's office. Please be patient with the staff and with the Pastor as we try to adjust.

## NUEVA OFICINA DE CANCELLERÍA PARA LA DIÓCESIS

En cursiva a continuación hay extractos de la declaración del Obispo Provost del 5 de mayo anunciando la compra del antiguo edificio del Consejo de Seguridad para las Oficinas Administrativas de la Diócesis de Lake Charles. Mis comentarios siguen.

*Después de una extensa consulta a partir de agosto de 2022 con el Consejo Presbiteral y el Consejo Diocesano de Finanzas, la Diócesis de Lake Charles ha decidido consolidar sus oficinas en un solo lugar mediante la compra de una instalación, el antiguo Consejo de Seguridad del Suroeste de Louisiana ubicado en 1201 Ryan Street. La antigua Cancillería en 414 Iris Street sufrió graves daños en el huracán Laura y el huracán Delta en el 2020. Este edificio permanece cerrado. Para continuar el ministerio, la Diócesis distribuyó sus oficinas en cinco instalaciones diferentes arrendadas y prestadas. Sin embargo, la Diócesis no puede continuar abordando el trabajo masivo de recuperación y continuar operando de manera efectiva en lugares dispares.*

*Después de evaluar las opciones disponibles, el Consejo Presbiteral, el Consejo de Finanzas y yo, como obispo, estamos de acuerdo en que comprar un edificio ya listo para mudarse es la opción más rentable. La reparación y adaptación de las estructuras actuales costaría al menos 6 millones de dólares. Se estimó que el reemplazo con una nueva construcción costaría al menos \$ 15 millones. El costo de comprar el nuevo edificio y renovarlo para nuestras necesidades será de aproximadamente \$ 3.3 millones, sustancialmente menos que las otras dos opciones y triplicando nuestro espacio disponible. Ningún fondo de recuperación asignado a la reconstrucción de parroquias o escuelas se redirigirá a la compra de la nueva cancillería. La Diócesis ha asegurado una hipoteca por una gran parte del costo total y financiará los pagos a través de operaciones generales.*

*Las oficinas diocesanas incluyen las siguientes: Administración, Escuelas Católicas, Tribunal, Vida Familiar, Pro-Vida, Matrimonio, Comunicaciones, Educación Religiosa, Fiscal, Vocaciones, Archivos, Protección de la Juventud y Ambiente Seguro, Recursos Humanos, Inmigración del Clero, Recuperación y Desarrollo.*

*Considero que se trata de un paso positivo en la dirección correcta. Por primera vez en la historia de la Diócesis, todas las oficinas diocesanas estarán bajo un mismo techo. Esta consolidación hará avanzar nuestro ministerio y servirá mejor a las necesidades de nuestra gente. Dedico esta nueva cancillería a Nuestra Señora de Lourdes en gratitud por su constante intercesión durante mis 16 años como obispo. Mientras le rezaba por esta decisión, estaba de pie en la gruta ubicada detrás de la catedral cuando me di cuenta de que la estatua de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes mira hacia la calle Bilbo hacia la ubicación de nuestras nuevas instalaciones. Ella nos ha estado cuidando todo este tiempo, y trataré de honrarla de una manera especial para que vele por ambos extremos de la calle Bilbo al igual que vela por toda la Iglesia.*

Formo parte tanto del Consejo Presbiteral como del Colegio de Consultores. En ambas capacidades voté para aprobar la compra. Esto debería decir algo porque usted sabe que estoy frustrado con el estancamiento en el proceso de recuperación para nosotros y para tantas otras parroquias. Francamente, creo que muchas de las decisiones relacionadas con la recuperación tomadas por la Diócesis no tienen mucho sentido. Esta decisión, sin embargo, tiene sentido. Porque tal oportunidad de presentarse de esta manera sólo puede ser obra de la Divina Providencia.

La única parte que me entristece es que el P. Joseph Caraway ha sido nombrado Vicecanciller de la Diócesis de Lake Charles y en esa capacidad se le ha encargado consolidar las muchas oficinas diocesanas. Él es más que capaz, y puedo ver por qué el obispo le confiaría esta tarea. La parte triste para St. Henry's es que consolidar las oficinas diocesanas es una responsabilidad de tiempo completo que no le permite tener mucha presencia en St. Henry's durante la semana. Todavía está técnicamente asignado como Vicario Parroquial aquí por el momento, pero ha tenido que renunciar a la mayoría de sus responsabilidades parroquiales (supervisión / capacitación de ministerios litúrgicos, ministerio juvenil, ministerio hispano, preparación matrimonial, anulaciones, confinamiento en casa, etc.). En términos prácticos, él está "en residencia" y ayuda con las misas. Ya no trabaja fuera de la oficina de St. Henry. Por favor, sea paciente con el personal y con el pastor mientras tratamos de adaptarnos.

## CORPUS CHRISTI EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION

**June 11, 2023. 2:30pm**

As part of the National Eucharistic Revival, each Deanery of the Diocese will hold a Eucharistic Procession for the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. The Procession for the North Central Deanery will take place on the property of the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception and will stop at each outdoor statue at a temporary altar. Como parte del Avivamiento Eucarístico Nacional, cada Decanato de la Diócesis celebrará una Procesión Eucarística para la Solemnidad del Corpus Christi. La Procesión para el Decanato Central Norte tendrá lugar en la propiedad de la Catedral de la Inmaculada Concepción y se detendrá en cada estatua al aire libre en un altar temporal. A cada parroquia de nuestro decanato se le asignará una estatua/altar para ese día. Para San Henry es la estatua de San Pedro Claver. Como decano, el Padre Cormier dirigirá la procesión y también dirigirá las oraciones en nuestro altar asignado. Después de la última estación, la procesión continúa de regreso a la Catedral con una reflexión a las 3pm. El programa concluye con la bendición a las 3:30pm.
