# Clergy Corner

Dear St. Henry's,

Your Church is a beautiful place, and I know that it is always filled with God's Grace in response to your many prayers. Many people have told me that I have much to be excited about because of your active community. I have been to your parish twice: once, last Good Friday on the Seven Church Pilgrimage; and then once my first summer as a seminarian to serve a wedding. Both times were very profound moments of prayer with assurance from God of His love and plans for me.

These prayer experiences were quite similar to the beginning of my vocations story. But before I became aware of it, I grew up baptist in Lake Charles with my parents and my two little siblings. I had a loving family and I grew up going to Henry Heights Elementary, playing outside, and playing video games. But my parents had various problems that continued to worsen as we got older, until my siblings and I were placed into foster care. However, I got placed with a loving and stable family, the Seilhans, who taught me the faith and received me as their own. It soon became clear to all of us that God was calling us to be together. When I was twelve years old they adopted me, I was baptised, and I made my first communion all on the same day.

Shortly after being adopted, I began to homeschool with the Seilhans. This was the first step in God calling us to serve as foreign missionaries with Family Missions Company. We did several short term missions to Mexico. Soon we realized that God was calling us to sell all that we had and serve as full-time missionaries in the Philippines. We lived in the Philippines for three years, doing many ministries but most importantly: preaching the gospel, witnessing to family life, and loving the poorest people of God. Our family did mostly children's ministry and one of our greatest tasks as kids was to befriend the kids around us with God's love.

After our time in the Philippines, our family moved to the mission base in Abbeville to help lead short term mission trips and serve at the mission base. I did trips to Costa Rica, Haiti and Mexico. Our family was homeschooling all this time, and this was during my high school years. Home schooling gave me the opportunity to serve the missions while in the states, work landscaping, play football, and do dual-enrollment college online during this time. Aside from all of this preparation and love that our Lord had given me, my vocations story began on the March for Life as I was praying for vocations. The Lord brought the reality of my own vocation before me. I entered seminary because I knew the Lord wanted me there to learn about Him and His love. When I finally decided to sign the papers all of my prayers turned to a holy peace and trust in God's plan. Every year the Lord keeps giving me the grace and new desires to continue following Him and pursuing His priesthood in the seminary.

I love learning and the Lord has fulfilled that desire in ways that I couldn't have imagined through the seminary. My hobbies are mostly reading, strength training, playing sports, board, and card games, and watching shows all with the great friends that God has given me. My favorite saint is Therese de Lisieux and my favorite Marian devotion is Our Lady of Sorrows. I have a devotion to St. Joseph the Worker and a strong devotion to the hearts of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. They have always led me towards our Lord with their humble ways of following God and working in the capacity that He gives them to build His kingdom in the hearts of all. I'm very excited to meet all of you. Know of my prayers now and always. In the never-failing love of Christ, Philip Seilhan.

Querida iglesia de San Henry,

Su Iglesia es un lugar hermoso, y sé que siempre está llena de la gracia de Dios en respuesta a sus muchas oraciones. Mucha gente me ha dicho que tengo mucho por que estar emocionado por su comunidad activa. He estado en su parroquia dos veces: una vez, el último Viernes Santo en la Peregrinación de las Siete Iglesias; y luego, una vez mi primer verano como seminarista para servir a una boda. Ambas veces fueron momentos muy profundos de oración con la seguridad de Dios de Su amor y planes para mí.

Estas experiencias de oración fueron bastante similares al comienzo de mi historia vocacional. Pero antes de darme cuenta, crecí baptista en Lake Charles con mis padres y mis dos pequeños hermanos. Tenía una familia amorosa y crecí yendo a la escuela de primaria Henry Heights, jugando afuera, y jugando video juegos. Pero mis padres tenían varios problemas que continuaron empeorando a medida que nos hicimos mayores, hasta que mis hermanos y yo fuimos colocados en hogares de acogimiento. Sin embargo, me colocaron con una familia amorosa y estable, los Seilhan, que me enseñaron la fe y me recibieron como propio. Eso pronto se hizo evidente para todos nosotros que Dios nos estaba llamando a estar juntos. Cuando tenía doce años de edad me adoptaron, fui bautizado e hice mi primera comunión todo el mismo día.

Poco después de ser adoptado, comencé a educado en casa con los Seilhan. Este fue el primer paso en Dios llamándonos a servir como misioneros extranjeros con la Compañía de Misiones Familiar. Hicimos varias misiones de corta duración a México. Pronto nos dimos cuenta de que Dios nos estaba llamando a vender todo lo que teníamos y servir como misioneros a tiempo completo en Filipinas. Vivimos en Filipinas durante tres años, haciendo muchos ministerios, pero lo más importante: predicando el evangelio, testificando la vida familiar, y amando a las personas más pobres de Dios. Nuestra familia trabajo principalmente el ministerio de niños y una de nuestras mayores tareas como niños era hacernos amigos de los niños que nos rodeaban con el amor de Dios.

Después de nuestro tiempo en Filipinas, nuestra familia se mudó a la base misionera en Abbeville para ayudar a dirigir viajes misioneros a corto plazo y servir en la base misionera. Hice viajes a Costa Rica, Haití, y México. Nuestra familia estaba recibiendo educación en casa todo este tiempo, y esto fue durante los años de escuela en secundaria. La educación en el hogar me dio la oportunidad de servir en las misiones mientras estaba en los estados, de trabajar en paisajismo, jugar fútbol americano y estar en la universidad de doble inscripción en línea durante este tiempo. Aparte de toda esta preparación y amor que nuestro Señor me había dado, mi historia con las vocaciones comenzó en la Marcha por la Vida mientras oraba por las vocaciones. El Señor trajo ante mí la realidad de mi propia vocación. Entré en el seminario porque sabía que el Señor quería que estuviera allí para aprender acerca de Él y de Su amor. Cuando finalmente decidí firmar los papeles, todas mis oraciones se convirtieron en una paz santa y en confianza en el plan de Dios.

Cada año el Señor sigue dándome la gracia y el deseo de seguir siguiéndolo y procurando Su sacerdocio en el seminario. Me encanta aprender y el Señor ha cumplido ese deseo de maneras que no podría haber imaginado a través del seminario. Mis pasatiempos son principalmente leer, entrenamiento de fuerza, practicar deportes, juegos de mesa y cartas, y ver programas con los grandes amigos que Dios me ha dado. Mi santa favorita es Santa Therese de Lisieux (Teresita del Niño Jesús) y mi devoción mariana favorita es Nuestra Señora de los Dolores. Tengo una devoción a San José Obrero y una fuerte devoción a los corazones de Jesús, María, y José. Siempre me han guiado hacia nuestro Señor con sus humildes maneras de seguir a Dios y trabajar en la capacidad que Él les da para construir Su reino en los corazones de todos. Estoy muy emocionado de conocerlos a todos. Sepan de mis oraciones ahora y siempre. En el amor infalible de Cristo, Philip Seilhan.
