

Clergy Corner

One of my teachers described seminary as a pressure cooker for maturity. The word seminary comes from the latin word *seminarium*, meaning seed bed or nursery. It is a place that is meant to cultivate virtue by providing the necessary opportunities. It aims to cultivate maturity in the four dimensions of formation; intellectual, spiritual, pastoral, and human.

Primarily seminary is a community, which cultivates these dimensions. It is a place that instills virtue through the friendships of shared goals. The overarching goal is for those called by God to realize that call as His priests. The main virtues that the seminary community teaches are patience and humility, which lay a foundation to learn and acquire all the virtues of a priest. Seminary is also foremost a university as this is the reason that we have to go away to a seminary, to learn from wise teachers. School is also the main work that a seminarian does, learning to think rationally and with the mind of the Church. Equally important and equally constant is communal prayer, which helps structure our day and ever remind us to depend on God. It also teaches the virtues of being accountable. Alongside communal prayer we learn to prioritize devotions, especially a holy hour, which keep our focus on the Lord and fosters the strength to continue through the rigors of growing in virtue, knowledge, and holiness. We also have various pastoral jobs both in the seminary, and in the local community that help us apply the skills and knowledge that we learn.

There is also intense community scrutiny that allows both members of the community and the formatos to help us learn to recognize and overcome our deficiencies in community life. The normal virtues and maturity required to do life well is what we call human formation and it underpins all the other dimensions of formation. Seminary also encourages growth in self-knowledge through reflection, prayer, and direction.

Seminary acts like a mirror. We meet regularly with both a formation advisor and a spiritual director. Our formation advisor helps us learn where we need to grow in formation. He is particularly concerned with our visible actions as they manifest in the community, not superficially but rather how others recognize our performance and progress. A spiritual director, however, aids more personally in discerning our vocation and growing in prayer.

Seminary is about stress. It calls for the sacrifice of family, desires, and autonomy, to enable one to find adventure and love in constrained situations. Seminary is not home; it is a place to acquire skills and discover God's call. We strive against seminary to return adapted to the stress of schooling as a more productive and configured disciple of Christ. Indispensable to this task is the friends that we make in seminary, whom we rely on to keep focus and find courage. It is a necessary part of human formation to develop friends through the challenges of seminary, who can be trusted companions in our journey to be configured to Christ the head.

Essentially, seminary is struggling to be holy and learning to see God through all of the normal tasks of daily life in the pressure cooker and mirror that is seminary. Seminary is an intentional configuration to Christ that entails becoming a well rounded person, acquiring a relationship with Christ, and understanding the call to shepherd His people. This entails the same daily tasks of a college student, but with special jobs, conferences, and intense focus on community, prayer, and obedience.

Uno de mis maestros describió seminario como una olla a presión para la madurez. La palabra seminario proviene de la palabra latina *seminarium*, que significa semillero o vivero. Es un lugar que está destinado a cultivar la virtud proporcionando las oportunidades necesarias. Su objetivo es cultivar la madurez en las cuatro dimensiones de la formación; intelectual, espiritual, pastoral y humano.

Principalmente seminario es una comunidad, que cultiva estas dimensiones. Es un lugar que infunde virtud a través de las amistades de objetivos compartidos. El objetivo general es que aquellos llamados por Dios realicen ese llamado como Sus sacerdotes. Las principales virtudes que enseña la comunidad del seminario son la paciencia y la humildad, que sientan las bases para aprender y adquirir todas las virtudes de un sacerdote.

Seminario es también ante todo una universidad, ya que esta es la razón por la que tenemos que ir a un seminario, para aprender de maestros sabios. La escuela es también el trabajo principal que hace un seminarista, aprendiendo a pensar racionalmente y con la mente de la Iglesia. Igualmente importante e igualmente constante es la oración comunitaria, que ayuda a estructurar nuestro día y siempre nos recuerda que debemos depender de Dios. También enseña las virtudes de ser responsable. Junto con la oración comunitaria, aprendemos a priorizar las devociones, especialmente una hora santa, que mantiene nuestro enfoque en el Señor y fomenta la fuerza para continuar a través de los rigores de crecer en virtud, conocimiento y santidad. También tenemos varios trabajos pastorales tanto en el seminario como en la comunidad local que nos ayudan a aplicar las habilidades y el conocimiento que aprendemos.

También hay un intenso escrutinio comunitario que permite que tanto los miembros de la comunidad como los formatos nos ayuden a aprender a reconocer y superar nuestras deficiencias en la vida comunitaria. Las virtudes normales y la madurez requeridas para hacer bien la vida es lo que llamamos formación humana y sustenta todas las demás dimensiones de la formación. Seminario también fomenta el crecimiento en el autoconocimiento a través de la reflexión, la oración y la dirección. Seminario actúa como un espejo. Nos reunimos regularmente con un asesor de formación y un director espiritual. Nuestro asesor de formación nos ayuda a aprender dónde necesitamos crecer en formación. Él está particularmente preocupado por nuestras acciones visibles tal como se manifiestan en la comunidad, no superficialmente, sino más bien cómo otros reconocen nuestro desempeño y progreso. Un director espiritual, sin embargo, ayuda más personalmente a discernir nuestra vocación y crecer en la oración.

El seminario se trata de estrés. Exige el sacrificio de la familia, los deseos y la autonomía, para permitirle a uno encontrar aventura y amor en situaciones limitadas. Seminario no es el hogar; es un lugar para adquirir habilidades y descubrir la llamada de Dios. Nos esforzamos contra el seminario para regresar adaptados al estrés de la escolarización como un discípulo de Cristo más productivo y configurado. Indispensables para esta tarea son los amigos que hacemos en seminario, en quienes confiamos para mantener el enfoque y encontrar valor. Es una parte necesaria de la formación humana desarrollar amigos a través de los desafíos del seminario, que puedan ser compañeros de confianza en nuestro camino para ser configurados con Cristo la cabeza. Esencialmente, seminario está luchando por ser santo y aprendiendo a ver a Dios a través de todas las tareas normales de la vida diaria en la olla a presión y el espejo que es seminario. El seminario es una configuración intencional con Cristo que implica convertirse en una persona completa, adquirir una relación con Cristo y comprender el llamado a pastorear a su pueblo. Esto implica las mismas tareas diarias de un estudiante universitario, pero con trabajos especiales, conferencias y un enfoque intenso en la comunidad, la oración y la obediencia.
