# Clergy Corner

## THINGS EVERY CATHOLIC SHOULD KNOW ABOUT MARRIAGE

Given the seriousness of the Sacrament of Matrimony, its public nature, and that many Catholics are sadly unaware or misinformed about important aspects of marriage, the following seeks to answer some frequently asked questions.

### Can Catholics marry outside of the Church?

Since Matrimony is a sacrament of the Church, when one or both of the spouses is a baptized Catholic, they must observe the Catholic form of marriage for it to be VALID. The Catholic form of marriage is when the spouses exchange consent before their Pastor or a priest or deacon delegated by the Pastor, in the presence of two witnesses, and according to the Church's ritual. Therefore, when a Catholic gets married "outside of the Church", whether in another faith community or just civilly, no sacrament exists and the Church cannot recognize it as a valid marriage. For further explanation of why the Catholic Form of Marriage exists, see numbers 1625-1631 of the Catechism.

### Can there be exceptions to the above?

Yes. A Catholic may request a special permission (called a "dispensation from canonical form") from their Bishop to celebrate their wedding outside of the Catholic form of marriage for a serious reason. For example, a Catholic seeks to marry a Baptist whose father is the pastor of the local Baptist church. The father wants to officiate at his daughter's wedding. In such a circumstance, the Church supplies the form of the Sacrament. Without such a dispensation, the marriage is invalid. The couple would still be expected to go through their Catholic parishes marriage preparation program to ensure that they are suitability prepared.

### What are the consequences of marrying outside of the Church without dispensation?

All our actions have consequences, especially public actions. When someone lives as husband and wife with someone who, in the eyes of God, is not their husband or wife, they place themselves in an ongoing and objective state of grave sin. Because marriage is a public act, it carries the added weight of scandal which can lead others into sin and error, especially youth. Those who obstinately persevere in manifest grave sin are not to be admitted to Holy Communion.

### Can a Catholic marry a non-Catholic?

Yes. For the marriage to be legal according to Church Law, the officiating priest/deacon must obtain permission from the local Bishop. To obtain this permission, the Catholic party must promise to remain faithful to the Catholic Faith and baptize and raise his/her children in the Catholic Faith. Couples should be aware that differences in faith can present challenges in a future marriage. "Difference of confession between the spouses does not constitute an insurmountable obstacle for marriage, when they succeed in placing in common what they have received from their respective communities, and learn from each other the way in which each lives in fidelity to Christ. But the difficulties of mixed marriages must not be underestimated." (CCC 1634).

### Can a divorced Catholic who has NOT remarried receive Holy Communion?

Yes! Many divorced Catholics mistakenly think that they cannot receive Communion simply by the fact of being divorced. This is not true. If the person seeks forgiveness for their part in the divorce through the Sacrament of Confession, then they can receive the Sacraments, provided they have not entered another relationship or civil remarriage. This is because civil divorce has zero effect on the sacramental marriage bond. "*what God has joined together, no human being must separate*" (Mt 19:6). Other romantic relationships would therefore be adulteress unless a church tribunal finds that the first marriage was not a real marriage from the beginning.

### What should a Catholic who has divorced and subsequently remarried civilly do?

First, maintain your relationship with God and the Church. The Lord and the Church still love you. We cannot, however, ignore the clear words of the Lord Jesus concerning divorce and remarriage. Talk to your parish priest about ways to move forward. In the meantime, since civil "remarriage" puts one in an ongoing state of adultery (grave sin), you should not receive the Sacraments to avoid offending the Lord further and inflicting even more damage upon your soul.

## COSAS QUE TODO CATÓLICO DEBE SABER SOBRE EL MATRIMONIO

Dada la seriedad del Sacramento del Matrimonio, su naturaleza pública, y que muchos católicos son tristemente inconscientes o mal informados sobre aspectos importantes del matrimonio, lo siguiente busca responder algunas preguntas frecuentes.

### ¿Pueden los católicos casarse fuera de la Iglesia?

Dado que el matrimonio es un sacramento de la Iglesia, cuando uno o ambos cónyuges son católicos bautizados, deben observar la forma católica del matrimonio para que sea VÁLIDA. La forma católica de matrimonio es cuando los cónyuges intercambian su consentimiento ante su pastor o un sacerdote o diácono delegado por el pastor, en presencia de dos testigos, y de acuerdo con el ritual de la Iglesia. Por lo tanto, cuando un católico se casa "fuera de la Iglesia", ya sea en otra comunidad de fe o solo civilmente, no existe ningún sacramento y la Iglesia no puede reconocerlo como un matrimonio válido. Para una explicación más detallada de por qué existe la forma católica de matrimonio, ver los números 1625-1631 del Catecismo.

### ¿Puede haber excepciones a lo anterior?

Sí. Un católico puede solicitar un permiso especial (llamado "dispensa de la forma canónica") de su obispo para celebrar su boda fuera de la forma católica de matrimonio por una razón seria. Por ejemplo, un católico busca casarse con un bautista cuyo padre es el pastor de la iglesia bautista local. El padre quiere oficiar en la boda de su hija. En tal circunstancia, la Iglesia suministra la forma del Sacramento. Sin tal dispensa, el matrimonio es inválido. Todavía se espera que la pareja pase por el programa de preparación matrimonial de sus parroquias católicas para asegurarse de que estén preparados para la idoneidad.

### ¿Cuáles son las consecuencias de casarse fuera de la Iglesia sin una dispensación?

Todas nuestras acciones tienen consecuencias, especialmente las acciones públicas. Cuando alguien vive como marido y mujer con alguien que, a los ojos de Dios, no es su esposo o esposa, se coloca en un estado continuo y objetivo de pecado grave. Debido a que el matrimonio es un acto público, conlleva el peso adicional del escándalo que puede llevar a otros al pecado y al error, especialmente a la juventud. Aquellos que obstinadamente perseveran en pecado grave manifiesto no deben ser admitidos a la Sagrada Comunión.

### ¿Puede un católico casarse con un no católico?

Sí. Para que el matrimonio sea legal de acuerdo con la Ley de la Iglesia, el sacerdote / diácono oficiante debe obtener el permiso del obispo local. Para obtener este permiso, la parte católica debe prometer permanecer fiel a la fe católica y bautizar y criar a sus hijos en la fe católica. Las parejas deben ser conscientes de que las diferencias en la fe pueden presentar desafíos en un futuro matrimonio. "La diferencia de confesión entre los cónyuges no constituye un obstáculo insuperable para el matrimonio, cuando logran poner en común lo que han recibido de sus respectivas comunidades, y aprenden el uno del otro el modo en que cada uno vive en fidelidad a Cristo. Pero las dificultades de los matrimonios mixtos no deben subestimarse". (CIC 1634).

### ¿Puede un católico divorciado que NO se ha vuelto a casar recibir la Sagrada Comunión?

¡Sí! Muchos católicos divorciados piensan erróneamente que no pueden recibir la Comunión simplemente por el hecho de estar divorciados. Esto no es cierto. Si la persona busca el perdón por su parte en el divorcio a través del Sacramento de la Confesión, entonces puede recibir los Sacramentos, siempre que no haya entrado en otra relación o nuevo matrimonio civil. Esto se debe a que el divorcio civil no tiene ningún efecto sobre el vínculo matrimonial sacramental. "*Lo que Dios ha unido, ningún hombre lo separa*" (Mt 19,6). Por lo tanto, otras relaciones románticas serían adulteras a menos que un tribunal eclesiástico encuentre que el primer matrimonio no fue un matrimonio real desde el principio.

### ¿Qué debe hacer civilmente un católico que se ha divorciado y posteriormente se ha vuelto a casar?

Primero, mantén tu relación con Dios y la Iglesia. El Señor y la Iglesia todavía te aman. Sin embargo, no podemos ignorar las claras palabras del Señor Jesús con respecto al divorcio y las segundas nupcias. Hable con su párroco sobre las maneras de avanzar. Mientras tanto, dado que el "nuevo matrimonio" civil pone a uno en un estado continuo de adulterio (pecado grave), no debe recibir los sacramentos para evitar ofender aún más al Señor e infligir aún más daño a su alma.




