

Clergy Corner

"Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created, and you shall renew the face of the earth. *Let us pray.* O God, who have taught the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant that in the same Spirit we may be truly wise and ever rejoice in his consolation. Through Christ our Lord. Amen" – (Prayer to the Holy Spirit)

The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Blessed Trinity. He is God. He is the Love and union between the Father and the Son. He pours forth from the life of the Trinity into the hearts of the faithful. The Holy Spirit is given to souls at Baptism. He is strengthened in Confirmation and imparts the Gifts and the Fruits of the Holy Spirit. These Gifts of the Holy Spirit are Permanent dispositions that make us docile to follow the promptings of the Holy Spirit (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1830). There are seven gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Understanding is the ability to comprehend the truths of God and holy religion. By faith we know them, but understanding enables us to make connections and grasp them. Counsel is the ability to discern good and evil and make good choices. It gives the soul prudence, enabling to judge promptly and rightly even in difficult situations. Fortitude is the courage and strength to suffer for the faith in persecution. One sees earthly fears in comparison to the supernatural vocation to come. Knowledge is having a deeper ability to see things as God sees them. We see earthly things and their relationship to God. It really shows how empty this world is, and the true purpose of things in relation to God. Piety enables our heart to have a filial love for God as our true loving Father. We understand who we are in relation to God. It increases our desire to love and pray to God in daily prayer and Holy Mass. Fear of the Lord is sovereign respect for God, and awe for who God is. It is also fear of separating ourselves from Him. It leads to renouncing our sins to avoid eternal separation from Him. Wisdom is the ability to see God's plan and to have faith in Him in all things. It is the most perfect of all gifts. It strengthens our faith, fortifies our hope, perfects charity, and promotes the practice of virtue to the highest degree. It sees all things in relation to the ultimate end and vocation toward holiness.

In addition to these Gifts, the Fruits of the Holy Spirit are also given to Baptized souls.

The fruits are the perfections that the Holy Spirit forms in us as the first fruits of eternal glory (CCC 1832). They result from living in the state of grace in union with the Holy Spirit. These are love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control and chastity. If you are ever in need of one of these areas, call upon the Holy Spirit. He desires to pour forth divine grace of the Gifts and Fruits into our souls and strengthen us through anything. Pray the prayer of the Holy Spirit and He will pour forth the fire of this Love.

Envía, Padre, tu Espíritu para darnos nueva vida y renovarás la faz de la tierra. Oremos: Oh Dios, que has iluminado los corazones de tus fieles con la luz del Espíritu Santo, haznos dóciles a tu Espíritu para gustar siempre el bien y gozar de su consuelo. Por Jesucristo nuestro Señor. Amén. – (Oración al Espíritu Santo)

El Espíritu Santo es la Tercera Persona de la Santísima Trinidad. Él es Dios. Él es el Amor y la unión entre el Padre y el Hijo. Él derrama de la vida de la Trinidad en el corazón de los fieles. El Espíritu Santo es dado a las almas en el Bautismo. Él se fortalece en la Confirmación e imparte los Dones y los Frutos del Espíritu Santo. Estos dones del Espíritu Santo son disposiciones permanentes que nos hacen dóciles para seguir los impulsos del Espíritu Santo (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, 1830). Hay siete dones del Espíritu Santo.

La Entendimiento es la capacidad de comprender las verdades de Dios y de la religión santa. Por la fe los conocemos, pero el entendimiento nos permite hacer conexiones y comprenderlos. El Consejo es la capacidad de discernir el bien y el mal y tomar buenas decisiones. Da al alma prudencia, permitiéndole juzgar con prontitud y rectitud incluso en situaciones difíciles. La Fortaleza es el coraje y la fuerza para sufrir por la fe en la persecución. Uno ve los temores terrenales en comparación con la vocación sobrenatural por venir. El Ciencia es tener una capacidad más profunda para ver las cosas como Dios las ve. Vemos las cosas terrenales y su relación con Dios. Realmente muestra cuán vacío está este mundo y el verdadero propósito de las cosas en relación con Dios. La Piedad permite que nuestro corazón tenga un amor filial por Dios como nuestro verdadero Padre amoroso. Entendemos quiénes somos en relación con Dios. Aumenta nuestro deseo de amar y orar a Dios en la oración diaria y en la Santa Misa. El Temor de Dios es el respeto soberano por Dios y el asombro por quién es Dios. Es también el miedo a separarnos de Él. Conduce a renunciar a nuestros pecados para evitar la separación eterna de Él. La Sabiduría es la capacidad de ver el plan de Dios y de tener fe en Él en todas las cosas. Es el más perfecto de todos los regalos. Fortalece nuestra fe, fortalece nuestra esperanza, perfecciona la caridad y promueve la práctica de la virtud en el más alto grado. Ve todas las cosas en relación con el fin último y la vocación a la santidad.

Además de estos Dones, los Frutos del Espíritu Santo también son dados a las almas bautizadas.

Los frutos son las perfecciones que el Espíritu Santo forma en nosotros como primicias de la gloria eterna (CIC 1832). Son el resultado de vivir en estado de gracia en unión con el Espíritu Santo. Estos son el amor, la alegría, la paz, la paciencia, la bondad, la generosidad, la mansedumbre, la fidelidad, la modestia, el dominio propio y la castidad. Si alguna vez necesitas una de estas áreas, invoca al Espíritu Santo. Él desea derramar la gracia divina de los Dones y Frutos en nuestras almas y fortalecer-nos a través de cualquier cosa. Rezad la oración del Espíritu Santo y Él derramará el fuego de este Amor.
