# Clergy Corner

## LENT BEGINS FEBRUARY 14. NOT YOUR TYPICAL VALENTINE'S DAY

This year, the beginning of Lent (Ash Wednesday) falls on the holiday of Valentine's Day which is a time when lovers traditionally go all out by treating their special someone to a nice dinner and special treats such as boxes of chocolate. For us as Catholics, however, the observance of Ash Wednesday as a day of holy fasting and abstinence from meat outweighs Valentine's Day. So, guys, you're off the hook! No need to treat your special lady to that gourmet meal or buy her that box of chocolates since February 14<sup>th</sup> is a day of fasting this year. *However*, I would highly recommend that you go ahead and treat your beloved to that meal and give her that box of chocolates on a *different* day...unless you want your Lent to be extra hard this year.

Seriously though, Lent is the time for us to deny ourselves as we prepare for the most sacred time of the year with prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Every Catholic, to enter more deeply into the life of Christ, is to participate in some way in the spiritual and penitential disciplines of Lent. **The regulations for the Catholic Church in the United States are as follows: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. These are the only two days in the entire year that Catholics are obligated to fast. That is not asking much. Instead, Holy Mother Church expects that as individuals we will strive to take on further acts of penance (including additional fasting) on our own. The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. The obligation to abstain from meat binds Catholics 14 years of age and older. The obligation to fast, limiting oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals during the day, binds Catholics from the age of 18 to 59. Those younger or older are encouraged to voluntarily embrace these disciplines in so far as they are able.**

"Interior sorrow for sin, accompanied by sincere turning from creatures and turning to God, is generally called penance. As a matter of fact, our whole life ought to be one continued penance. Our Lord says: 'Unless you shall do penance, you shall all likewise perish' (Lk 13:3)... St. Jerome says we can no more attain everlasting life without penance, than we can get at the kernel of a nut without breaking the shell." (The Catechism Explained)

Divine and Natural Law holds that all the faithful are morally bound to do penance. The Fourth Precept of the Church obliges Catholics to observe the penance of fasting and abstinence for Lent. Fasting and abstinence should never endanger one's health. Avoiding some form of permissible entertainment or performing sacrificial acts of charity, for example, could replace the fasting and abstinence when health is a consideration.

Finally, with any penitential discipline, both the letter and the spirit are to be maintained. For example, replacing meat with a gourmet seafood meal is not in keeping with penitential practice. Also, the increasingly popular practice of hosting "crawfish boils" and entertainments on Good Friday is highly inappropriate. Good Friday remains an extraordinary and solemn day on which we recall the suffering and death of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Good Friday should remain a day of fasting, abstinence, prayer, penance, and interior and exterior quiet.

## LA CUARESMA INICIA EL 14 DE FEBRERO. NO ES EL TÍPICO DÍA DE SAN VALENTÍN

Este año, el comienzo de la Cuaresma (Miércoles de Ceniza) cae en la festividad del Día de San Valentín, que es un momento en el que los enamorados tradicionalmente hacen todo lo posible para invitar a su persona especial a una buena cena y golosinas especiales como cajas de chocolate. Sin embargo, para nosotros, como católicos, la observancia del Miércoles de Ceniza como un día de ayuno sagrado y abstinencia de carne pesa más que el Día de San Valentín. Así que, chicos, ¡están fuera de peligro! No es necesario que inviten a su dama especial a esa comida gourmet o le compren esa caja de chocolates, ya que el 14 de febrero es un día de ayuno este año. *Sin embargo*, les recomiendo encarecidamente que lo hagan e inviten a su amada a esa comida y le den esa caja de bombones en un día *diferente*... a menos que quieran que su Cuaresma sea más dura este año.

Sin embargo, en serio, la Cuaresma es el tiempo para que nos neguemos a nosotros mismos mientras nos preparamos para el momento más sagrado del año con oración, ayuno y limosna. Todo católico, para entrar más profundamente en la vida de Cristo, debe participar de alguna manera en las disciplinas espirituales y penitenciales de la Cuaresma. **Las regulaciones para la Iglesia Católica en los Estados Unidos son las siguientes: El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días de ayuno y abstinencia. Estos son los únicos dos días en todo el año en que los católicos están obligados a ayunar. Eso no es pedir mucho. En cambio, la Santa Madre Iglesia espera que, como individuos, nos esforcemos por asumir más actos de penitencia (incluido el ayuno adicional) por nuestra cuenta. Los otros viernes de Cuaresma son días de abstinencia de carne.**

La obligación de abstenerse de comer carne obliga a los católicos mayores de 14 años. La obligación de ayunar, limitándose a una comida completa y dos comidas más ligeras durante el día, obliga a los católicos desde los 18 hasta los 59 años. Se anima a los jóvenes o a los mayores a que adopten voluntariamente estas disciplinas en la medida de sus posibilidades.

"El dolor interior por el pecado, acompañado de un sincero apartamiento de las criaturas y de un giro a Dios, se llama generalmente penitencia. De hecho, toda nuestra vida debería ser una penitencia continua. Nuestro Señor dice: "Si no hacéis penitencia, todos pereceréis igualmente" (Lc. 13,3) ... San Jerónimo dice que no podemos alcanzar la vida eterna sin penitencia, como tampoco podemos llegar al grano de una nuez sin romper la cáscara". (El Catecismo explicado)

La ley divina y natural sostiene que todos los fieles están moralmente obligados a hacer penitencia. El cuarto precepto de la Iglesia obliga a los católicos a observar la penitencia del ayuno y la abstinencia durante la Cuaresma. El ayuno y la abstinencia nunca deben poner en peligro la salud. Evitar alguna forma de entretenimiento permisible o realizar actos sacrificiales de caridad, por ejemplo, podría reemplazar el ayuno y la abstinencia cuando la salud es una consideración.

Finalmente, con cualquier disciplina penitencial, tanto la letra como el espíritu deben ser mantenidos. Por ejemplo, sustituir la carne por una comida gourmet de mariscos no está en consonancia con la práctica penitencial. Además, la práctica cada vez más popular de organizar "hervidos de cangrejo de río" y entretenimientos el Viernes Santo es muy inapropiada. El Viernes Santo sigue siendo un día extraordinario y solemne en el que recordamos el sufrimiento y la muerte de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo. El Viernes Santo debe seguir siendo un día de ayuno, abstinencia, oración, penitencia y tranquilidad interior y exterior.
