

Clergy Corner

This week on March 19th we celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph, spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This feast focuses on his work in the mystery of redemption, as faithful and humble husband of Mary, and the earthly father of the Son of God. St. Joseph is revered as the second greatest saint only behind the Blessed Virgin Mary. His example and holiness excel beyond all other saints in human history. He does not say any words in Scripture but is mentioned several times. He is appeared to by angels in his dreams and he simply and humbly does God's will immediately. He is an incredible intercessor for us to be docile to God's holy will.

Fr. Donald Calloway wrote a 33-day Consecration to St. Joseph that gives a deeper insight into the incredible life of the saint. He describes 10 "Wonders" of St. Joseph. Fr. Calloway describes the marvel of Joseph as Spiritual Father. The Blessed Mother was Immaculate by the Holy Spirit from her conception. But Joseph was given so much grace throughout his life to be the most just and reverent man possible. Who else could live in a house with a perfect wife and a Son who was God? Joseph was the legal guardian of God himself. He taught Jesus his accent, his manners, his work, even how to pray as a good and holy Jew. God gave him the grace to do it perfectly.

Further, Joseph was a young husband of Mary. Many statues describe him as an old man to make an excuse for his chaste. But Fr. Calloway describes him as a young and virile man. Who else could walk with his wife and child through the arduous and difficult journeys which estimated around 1200 miles from the time they left Nazareth? Joseph was a young and strong man to defend and protect his family. His chastity and purity were due to his virtue and God's grace. His is an incredible protector for all regarding purity. He desires to intercede for anyone struggling with the vices of lust.

Lastly St. Joseph is the Terror of demons. The devil was infuriated that God himself would become a creature lower than the angels as a man. The devil hates even more that Jesus was even obedient and submitted to a man, his earthly father. The filial obedience of Jesus to Joseph infuriates and terrifies the devil. St. Joseph has authority over the incarnate Word, and this authority extends over all evil. Fr. Calloway says, "Satan is terrified that St. Joseph continues to exercise his paternal influence in heaven through his extraordinary intercession with the Son of God." The devil is terrified of Joseph still today. St. Joseph desires to intercede and protect anyone who calls on him.

St. Joseph was the spouse of Mary, earthly father of Jesus, and he desires to be our Father as well. He wants to protect anyone who calls upon him, especially mothers, fathers, and families. Turn to St. Joseph. He will bring you closer to the Son of God.

Remember, O most chaste spouse of the Virgin Mary, that never has it been known that anyone who asked for your help and sought your intercession was left unaided. Full of confidence in your power, I hasten to you, and beg your protection. Listen, O foster-father of the Redeemer, to my humble prayer, and in your goodness hear and answer me. Amen. – Memorare to St. Joseph .

Esta semana, el 19 de marzo, celebramos la Solemnidad de San José, esposo de la Santísima Virgen María. Esta fiesta se centra en su obra en el misterio de la redención, como esposo fiel y humilde de María, y padre terrenal del Hijo de Dios. San José es venerado como el segundo santo más grande solo detrás de la Santísima Virgen María. Su ejemplo y santidad sobresalen más que todos los demás santos en la historia humana. No dice ninguna palabra en las Escrituras, pero se le menciona varias veces. Los ángeles se le aparecen en sueños y él hace la voluntad de Dios de inmediato. Él es un intercesor increíble para que seamos dóciles a la santa voluntad de Dios.

El Padre Donald Calloway escribió una Consagración de 33 días a San José que da una visión más profunda de la increíble vida del santo. Describe 10 "Maravillas" de San José. El P. Calloway describe la maravilla de José como Padre Espiritual. La Santísima Virgen fue Inmaculada por el Espíritu Santo desde su concepción. Pero a José se le dio mucha gracia a lo largo de su vida para ser el hombre más justo y reverente posible. ¿Quién más podría vivir en una casa con una esposa perfecta y un Hijo que fuera Dios? José era el guardián legal de Dios mismo. Le enseñó a Jesús su acento, sus modales, su trabajo, incluso cómo orar como un judío bueno y santo. Dios le dio la gracia de hacerlo perfectamente.

Además, José era un joven esposo de María. Muchas estatuas lo describen como un anciano para excusar su castidad. Pero el P. Calloway lo describe como un hombre joven y viril. ¿Quién más podría caminar con su esposa y su hijo a través de los arduos y difíciles viajes que estimaban alrededor de 1200 millas desde el momento en que salieron de Nazaret? José era un hombre joven y fuerte para defender y proteger a su familia. Su castidad y pureza se debían a su virtud y a la gracia de Dios. El suyo es un protector increíble para todos en lo que respecta a la pureza. Desea interceder por cualquiera que luche contra los vicios de la lujuria.

Por último, San José es el Terror de los demonios. El diablo se enfureció porque Dios mismo se convertiría en una criatura inferior a los ángeles como hombre. El diablo odia aún más que Jesús fuera obediente y se sometiera a un hombre, su padre terrenal. La obediencia filial de Jesús a José enfurece y aterroriza al diablo. San José tiene autoridad sobre el Verbo encarnado, y esta autoridad se extiende sobre todo mal. El P. Calloway dice: "Satanás está aterrorizado de que San José continúe ejerciendo su influencia paternal en el cielo a través de su extraordinaria intercesión ante el Hijo de Dios". El diablo está aterrorizado por José todavía hoy. San José desea interceder y proteger a cualquiera que lo invoque.

San José fue el esposo de María, padre terrenal de Jesús, y desea ser también nuestro Padre. Quiere proteger a cualquiera que lo invoque, especialmente a las madres, los padres y las familias. Diríjase a San José. Él te acercará al Hijo de Dios. Acuédate, oh castísima esposa de la Virgen María, que nunca se ha sabido que alguien que pidiera tu ayuda y buscara tu intercesión quedara sin ayuda. Lleno de confianza en tu poder, me apresuro a ir a ti y te suplico tu protección. Escucha, oh, padre adoptivo del Redentor, mi humilde oración, y en tu bondad escúchame y respóndeme. Amén. – Memorare a San José.


