### Gaudete Sunday

On Gaudete Sunday, in the middle of Advent, the Church lightens the mood a little and the priest may wear rose vestments. The change in colour, from purple, provides us with encouragement to continue our spiritual preparation, especially prayer and fasting. However, it shows a shift in the season of Advent, away from repentance and towards celebration. For this same reason, the third candle of the Advent wreath is also rose coloured. The term 'Gaudete' refers to the first word of the Entrance Antiphon "Rejoice".

"Rejoice in the Lord always, again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near."
