Tuition Agreement

- Part I: General Family Information: Please complete in its entirety, including which school your child would attend if they were at a public school.
- Part II: Tuition Rates
- Part III: Tuition Deposit: \$50 per student/\$100 per family.

Current families: the deposit will be invoiced in FACTS upon receiving the agreement back New families: please send a check to 795 Havens Corners Road Gahanna, Ohio 43230 Deposit amount is deducted from total tuition due.

- Part IV: Saint Matthew the Apostle Catholic Parish Tuition Grant
 - Only needs to be filled out by St. Matthew parishioners that are applying for the Parish Tuition Grant. BOTH parents/guardians must sign the Tuition Grant application/ agreement.
- Part V: Tuition Payment Contract

Select tuition payment option: one, two, four, or ten month plan.

Payments are due August 15th - May 15th

BOTH parents/guardians sign and date the bottom of Part V

If you are new to the school, please create a FACTS account and payment plan (link at the bottom of the school homepage) for 2022-2023 school year by April 29th. Existing families don't need to do anything in FACTS. We will invoice you for the deposit; and your payment plan, banking/credit card information from last year will stay the same.

Parishes assume a large part of the cost of operating the school. Your financial support of St. Matthew the Apostle Catholic Parish and Church of the Resurrection is essential. Families who are not parish members, have no record of regular contributions, or have no record of ministry involvement, or do not attend Mass regularly will not receive the parish grant and will be responsible for the non-parishioner tuition rate.

Please remember all 2021-2022 tuition, library fees, school cafeteria negative balances must all be paid in full by June 8th. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the school office. Our office will close for the summer on June 17th and will reopen again on August 11th.



Dear Parents/Guardians of St. Matthew the Apostle Catholic School Children,

Catholic education is a great gift, and in order to provide that gift to as many families as possible, St. Matthew the Apostle Catholic Parish offers a tuition grant to support active, practicing parishioners of St. Matthew. I want to help each of you understand the tuition grant, which is provided by God's grace and the generosity of St. Matthew parishioners.

Through the tuition grant, the parish offsets a portion of tuition costs as an investment in families committed to raising children who live their faith fully and authentically and who are helping our parish mission to worship, serve, and evangelize. Grants are made possible through offertory Mass donations from parishioners, ongoing fundraising, and development efforts. The cost to our parish of educating a St. Matthew the Apostle Catholic School student next school year will be \$6,750 (\$6,850 for PreK). Eligible families would pay \$4,495 (\$4700 for PreK) for their first child, receiving a tuition grant of \$2,255 (\$2,150 for PreK).

When discerning which families will receive the tuition grant, we look for families who are active, practicing Catholics. Living this mission to worship, serve, and evangelize involves worshiping at Mass on every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation; registering at St. Matthew Parish; engaging in personal and family prayer; listening to, reflecting on, and living the Gospel; contributing financially to the parish offertory collection; and participating in parish and school activities and ministries. Families who are not active, practicing Catholics as outlined above should expect to pay full tuition.

Existing families will be invoiced for the 2022-2023 tuition deposit in FACTS.

Part IV: St. Matthew the Apostle Catholic Parish Tuition Grant Criteria

- 1. Students are baptized.
- 2. Be registered with St. Matthew the Apostle Catholic Parish as members.
- 3. All family members participate in the life of worship at the parish by attending Sunday Mass each week, keeping holy the Lord's Day and attending Holy Days of Obligation.
- 4. All family members participate in the life of discipleship and service at the parish by being involved in at least one of the many non-school ministries, groups or events.
- 5. Support the parish's mission through financial donations in proportion to your blessings using Online Giving or parish offertory envelopes. In gratitude, we make a return to the Lord for all the good that He has done for us. We suggest a rate of 2.5% of the weekly family income.
- 6. Track all family members' time for both school and parish involvement using the TrackItForward Time Tracking System, link at bottom of school homepage.
- 7. Families new to St. Matthew the Apostle Catholic Parish and School will be considered eligible for the parish tuition grant when they have been registered and have met the above criteria, or when they have provided the parish office with a written statement from their previous pastor about their active engagement in worship, service and regular financial support at that parish.
- 8. Be in compliance with the Attendance/Absence Policy detailed in the Parent/Student Handbook.
