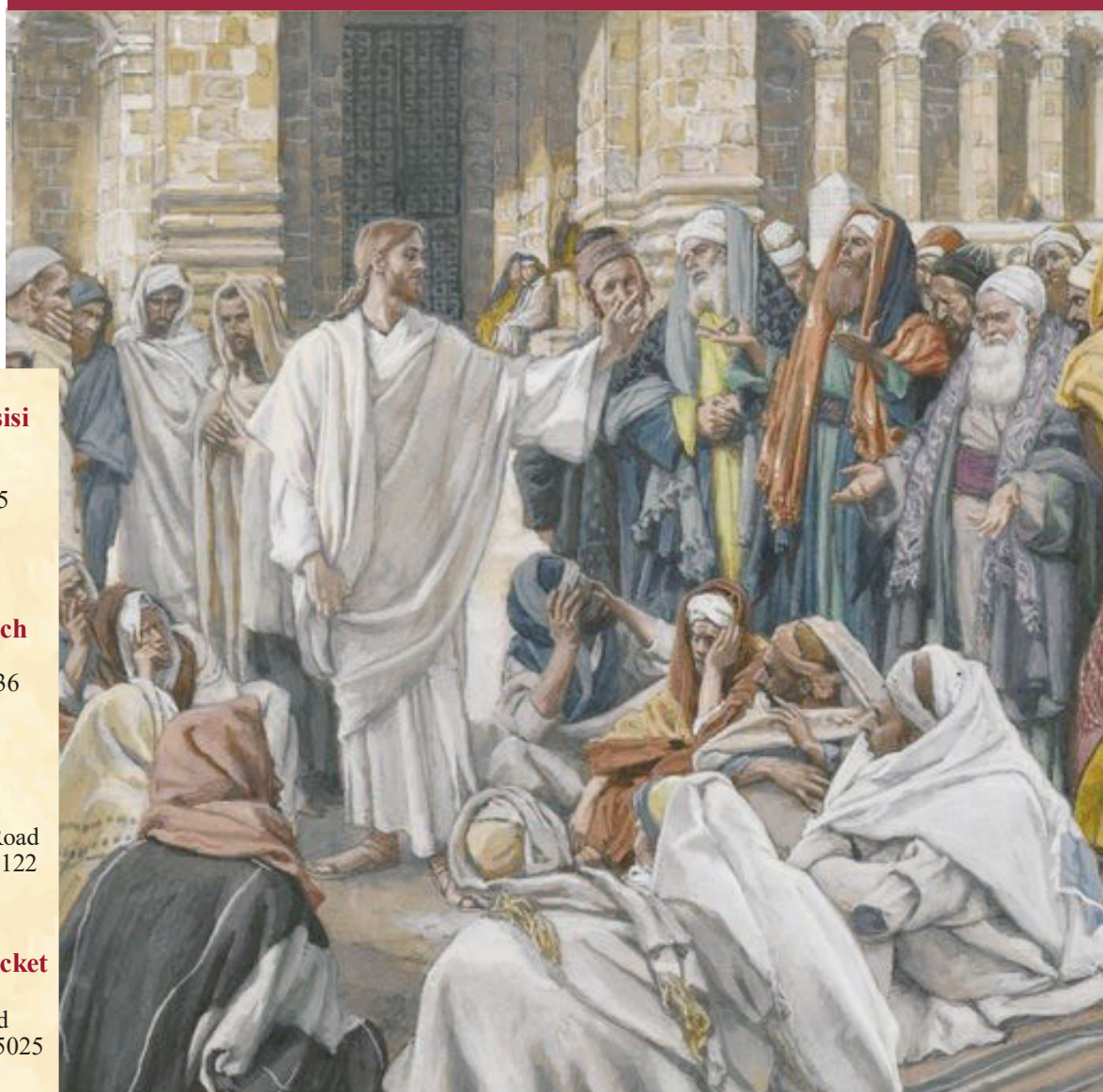

PROPOSED SUNDAY MASS SCHEDULE

The Mass schedule has been a topic of conversation since I came to this parish in July 2020. I learned quickly that everyone has an idea or opinion about the “best” Mass time and location. And guess what? They’re all different! This became very clear to me when I took a poll during a Pastoral Council Meeting a while back, asking members to write down their ideal Mass time and location. Of the people present at that meeting, there were **9 different responses** from just 11 people! This confirmed my earlier realization that there is *no way to please everyone!*

One of the Mass times that has continually come up as a “favorite” is a Sunday evening Mass. Several years back, I learned there was a 7:00PM evening Mass at Saint Elizabeth, and that a significant number of the faithful attended this evening celebration. At the time of the formation of Grouping 225 in October 2018, this Mass was removed from the Sunday schedule. Upon review of our current Mass schedule, it has been proposed that the re-implementation of a Sunday evening Mass would be well received and advantageous for the good of the whole community.

Along with the need for a Sunday evening Mass is a sincere effort to grow the Youth Ministry Program. In recent months, the Youth Ministry Office and meeting place has been established in the Annex, the former Education or School Building on the grounds at Saint Thomas à Becket. In this short period of time, the number of students attending youth group activities (primarily on Sunday evenings) has been growing steadily. Beginning in September, every Sunday evening, either the middle school (EDGE) or high school students (Lifeteen) programs will gather for instructions and activities in the Annex, Vincentian Hall, the Pavilion, open field, and the Church.

These factors have led the clergy team to propose the **implementation of a Sunday evening Mass at Saint Thomas à Becket Church at 5:00PM**. The hope is that this Mass will be attended by our young people and their families who are involved in youth ministry events on Sunday evenings and parishioners in general. In addition, contemporary style music will accompany the Sunday evening Mass that will correspond with the music used for youth ministry activities and our monthly Praise and Adoration.

The process of altering the Mass schedule is not just a matter of implementation by the pastor or clergy team. Rather, it is a collaborative process involving the whole parish. I have already begun this discussion with staff members and the pastoral council. The next step is to inform you, the parishioners, and to consider any feedback or suggestions that may be brought forth. Lastly, a proposal will be forwarded to the Regional Vicar, the Reverend Joseph Sioli, for consideration and possible approval.

I am asking you to take this proposal to heart, and please feel free to share your comments or suggestions with me. You can either write a letter and mail it or put it in the collection basket. You can also send your comments to my email at: pzywan@diopitt.org. Due to the volume of suggestions that I anticipate, no further correspondence will be given after the acknowledgement of your response. **All comments regarding this proposal must be received by Friday, August 12.**

Thank you for your continued support and prayers for our parish. Our mission must be focused on addressing our current needs and passing on the faith to the next generation.

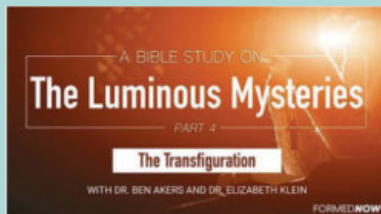

From the Heart

Faith Formation for 2022-2023

Father Michael Schmitz says, "After the Bible, the Catechism is the most important book for Catholics." The catechism is more than a reference book, it is the unpacking and summary of all that Christians have believed for thousands of years and what Christians believe today.

Family Catechesis precedes, accompanies, and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith. Parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation as children of God. The parish is the Eucharistic community and the heart of the liturgical life of Christian families: it is a privileged place for the catechesis of children and parents.

— Catechism of the Catholic Church

A Faith Formation program for children accompanies and supports parents on their mission to: "train a child in the way they should go so that when they are old, they will not depart from it" (Proverbs 22:6).

The Second Vatican Council declared that: "Parents are the ones who must create a family atmosphere animated by love and respect for God and others, in which the well-rounded personal and social education of children is fostered." Training includes teaching, helping, modeling, and participation. Children are observant. They look to you and those around them to learn what they should do and how they should do it.

Faith Formation of God's Children — young, old, and everyone in between — is a priority at Triumph of the Holy Cross Parish. We are grateful that you are asking



us to partner with and support you in your vocation of sharing faith, God's love, and the mystery of salvation with your child. Encouraged by the love that God has first shown to us, we His disciples, will build up the Kingdom of God by assisting all people, especially the youngest among us, to grow in their love of Christ and His Church. Faith Formation *informs, forms, and transforms* people of all ages to live a robust and life-giving Christian faith. This holistically involves the head, the heart, and the hands. And Faith Formation does the very same for the Christian community: "While expressed in many different ways, faith formation seeks to help people: [and] grow in their relationship with God for the whole of life."

Working with you to form God's children in the way, truth and life of Jesus is a priceless gift. As you know, however, the Eucharist is the heart of our Catholic Faith. Without weekly reception of this Most Blessed Sacrament, it is difficult to keep faith alive and meaningful in our lives. Through your weekly Mass attendance, reception of the Eucharist, and Faith Formation sessions, I truly believe that you and your children will grow in knowledge, faith, hope, and love of Jesus and His Church in the coming catechetical year.

This year's catechetical theme is " **This is my Body given for YOU**" (Luke 22:19), serving as a launching point for the next three years for the entire Catholic Church's study of the EUCHARIST.
