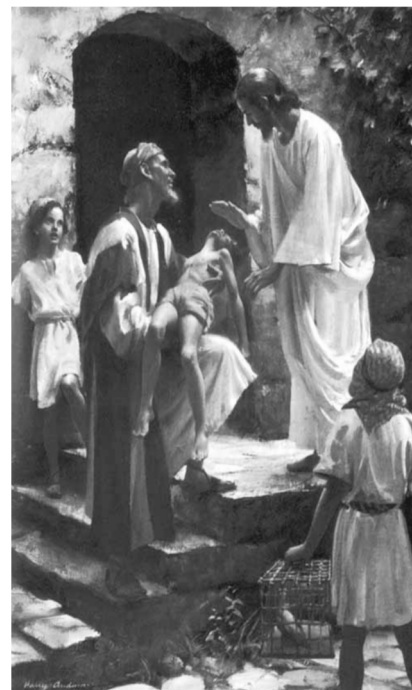

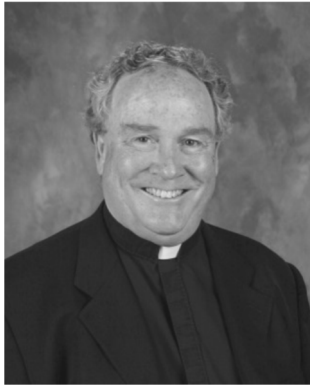

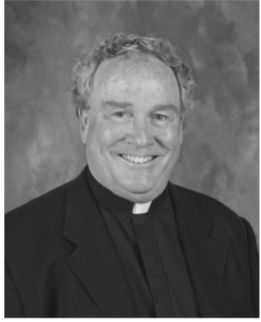
LAS CUATRO CONDICIONES:
