

GENERAL INFORMATION

Date & Duration: The tournament will take place on Saturday, August 29th. The expected times for the day are the following (subject to change):

- Check-in begins: 7:45am
- Captain's meeting: 8:30am
- Morning announcements & prayer: 8:45am
- Round robin play begins: 9:00am
- Tournament play begins: 2:00pm
- Championship games: 5:45pm

Registration deadlines:

- Guaranteed shirt size: 8/1
- Final registration: 8/23 (all participants will receive a shirt, but if registration occurs after 8/1, you will receive whatever size is available)
- Refund policy: If your team must drop out of the tournament after registering, you have until the end of the day on 8/23 to receive a full refund. Refunds will not be given after the deadline for any reason.

Inclement weather: Play will continue rain or shine at the discretion of tournament staff and the host. In the event of severe weather, play will be suspended immediately. If conditions are expected to improve, play will resume once it is safe to do so. If the tournament is canceled after play has begun, teams will receive a prorated refund based on the portion of the tournament completed. Teams will receive a full refund if the tournament is canceled before any play begins.

Food & drinks: There will be no food trucks/vendors available at this tournament. Please bring your own food and drink. You will be allowed to bring in coolers to your base camp area. Also feel free to utilize restaurants/grocery stores around Shakopee to cover your food and drink needs.

Base camp: To build community and friendship amongst the Catholic community and participants in the tournament, there will be a designated area for all teams to set up their base camp. It is highly encouraged to bring a canopy tent to designate your spot and also give you a break from the sun/heat when you're not playing. We ask that you set up your canopy tents right next to other canopy tents to ensure there's enough room for everyone and to encourage interaction between participants.

Restrooms: Porta potties will be available for use.

General admission/spectators: Spectators are free, there is no general admission fee. We highly encourage your family, friends, and parishioners to come out and enjoy the day. Bring a lawn chair!

Parking: Parking is designated on the map.

Pets: No pets are allowed.
