


IN MEMORY of ME





"He is not God of the dead, but of the living." Luke 20:27-38


Are you afraid of dying? Death should not instill fear to those who believe in a loving and just God. After all, death does not exist in heaven. Jesus points that out in today's gospel. The Sadducees do not believe in a resurrection. So they use an argument meant to ridicule the notion of a life after death. What happens to a woman married seven times on earth to seven men who have died? When she dies who will she be married to in heaven?

Jesus rebukes their argument by showing that the reason people get married on earth is to have children in order to procreate the species. Why? Because we die. We need to keep bringing new life into the world because all life will die. On the other hand in heaven there is no death. We live forever in the presence of God. Therefore, no one needs to marry and procreate. Likewise Jesus uses a Scripture passage to point out that those who have died and were holy in God's eyes, continue to live after they die to this world. God is the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, these men who are dead to this world are still alive in the heaven.

While all of us will face mortal death, those who have chosen to follow Christ as His disciples will see eternal life with God in heaven. The only death that last forever comes when we allow mortal sin to rule our lives on earth. Christ offers eternal life to all those who follow Him on earth. Do our lives reflect that commitment?






Thanksgiving Day Is Coming!
