



"Prepare the way of the Lord."

Mark 1:3

Throughout the history of humanity, we find God sending people to announce that he would send them a Messiah. The Messiah would help guide the people to God the Father. These prophets told the people how they must prepare themselves so that when the Messiah came they would find themselves ready and waiting.

In the gospel we read of John the Baptizer who preceded the coming of Jesus the Messiah and Son of God. He told the people to prepare themselves. Many people failed to recognize Jesus as the Messiah. They were not prepared.

Before going back to the Father in heaven Jesus promised that he would come again to judge the living and the dead. This Final coming would mark the end of this world. Those found ready and waiting would find a place in heaven. Those not prepared would spend eternity in Hell.

In the second reading the author tells us that this day of Final Judgment 'will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a mighty roar and the elements will be dissolved by fire, and the earth and everything done on it will be found out."

God kept His promise to send a Messiah and Jesus came into the world. Many people were not prepared. Jesus promises that He will come again. Are we prepared? How will God judge us should He come at this moment? Will He judge us ready and waiting or unprepared?

Jubilation to Share

Sometimes you have something to share with people that causes you to well up inside with excitement to the point of going crazy. A pregnancy test, a pay raise, a college acceptance, a wedding or engagement are all examples of moments in life when we might be bursting at the seams to tell somebody the good news. When we finally get the chance to tell somebody, joy just seems to flow through us with ease. We literally want the entire world to share in our jubilation.

When was the last time you shared with a friend or loved one how much your faith in Jesus means to you? You don't feel the same motivation to share? Are you not overwhelmed with a desire to spread the Good News?
