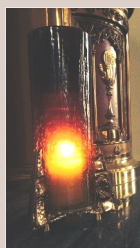

## WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

Today, May 12, 2019, is World Day of Prayer for Vocations. In our Carnegie-Greentree-Scott Parish Communities, we have many activities supporting vocations to the priesthood and religious life. In one parish, the faith formation students send cards to the seminarians in formation in the Diocese of Pittsburgh at the beginning of the school year, Christmas, and Valentine's Day. Two of our parishes are dedicated to praying a litany for priests prior to one weekday mass a week. One parish has a traveling chalice that is taken into homes to serve as a visible reminder to pray for vocations. We also have active "31 Clubs" where members sign up for a specific date on which they pledge to pray a rosary for vocations to the priesthood every month. These are just a few of the ways our communities support vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

Many from our parishes have answered the call to the priesthood and religious life. There are at least 6 living religious sisters and 17 living priests who grew up in SEAS, SMOS, or SSJ. We are also blessed with young people currently discerning vocations and currently in formation.

On this day, and as often as possible, please take a moment to thank our Clergy Team: Fr. Grecco, Fr. Alek, Fr. Robin, Fr. Jerome, Deacon Kevin, and Deacon Jim, for the sacrifices they make to serve and guide us closer to Jesus Christ. Thank God for the blessing of their faithful ministry daily.

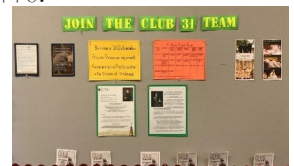
