

This is a re-certification training program that is being required of ALL clergy, staff, and volunteers. It is a follow-up course to Protecting God's Children that you have taken to become a volunteer; some people have taken it as far back as 2003! Additionally, every three years everyone will be required to re-certify. It takes a little more than an hour to complete online. You will watch informative videos and answer questions. At the conclusion you will be able to earn and print out a certificate. The GOOD NEWS is that you do not have to send me a copy; I have access to print it out and put it in your file. Just go to virtus.org and log in; if you forgot your password, click on "Need login information" under the password box. The ACCESS word is PROTECT.
