- Develop and maintain relationships with media outlets to inform and engage interest in parish activities
- Cultivate and nurture relationships with current and potential corporate and foundation sponsors, area businesses and individual donors
- Write grant proposals and reports to corporate entities and foundations parish programs
- Explore opportunities for the parish to participate in local civic events (Arts Festival, Krazy Days, etc.) in the communities she serves
- Develop and implement comprehensive publicity, marketing, and public relations strategy
- Present goals and results on a regular basis to pastor, Councils, and staff.
