Team Contract

We are so excited that your child has chosen to become a member of our cross country team! Please attend practice on **Monday, August 18th** until 4:15! If you cannot make it on Monday, August 18th, you must contact Mrs. Nunez or Mrs. Dupas. As a member of a team representing Our Lady of Prompt Succor, you agree to follow these team rules:

1. The student athlete must maintain a minimum grade point average of 78 in all major academic areas. Academic probation plans will be initiated on an individual basis.
2. The student athlete must maintain a minimum grade "C" in conduct. If a "C" is not maintained, the student athlete will forfeit his/her position on the team.
3. The student athlete must be in attendance more than four hours during the school day in order to participate after school in practice or games. Since meets are on Saturdays, the student athlete must be in school the Friday before the meet.
4. Any student athlete receiving one suspension and/or two detentions during the season will forfeit his/her position on the team.
5. The student athlete must attend practice and meets. If the student athlete is going to miss a practice or a meet for any reason (including being absent from school) he/she must inform the coach, moderator, and/or athletic director.
6. If a student athlete is injured, they are still required to attend all practices and meets for the team to which they are a member of or they forfeit their position on the team.
7. The student athlete must come to practice prepared – t-shirt, shorts, and shoes that are sport appropriate. Coming to practice without being prepared could result in disciplinary action.
8. On practice days, the student athlete may not leave campus without an adult and return.
9. Dad's Club has donated uniforms for our athletic teams. Uniforms will be distributed before the first game and should be returned promptly when the season is over. The student athlete is responsible for the care of his/her uniform, which is school property. Please read the care instructions before washing/drying. Students who do not keep their uniform in good condition may have disciplinary consequences. Parents are required to pay for any lost or damaged uniforms. To replace a uniform, the cost is \$30 for the top and \$30 for the bottom.
10. Each sport will require a \$40.00 athletic fee.
11. For a student to be eligible for an athletic jacket and a tri-athlete towel (if they participate in 2 additional sports), they must attend at least 2 meets.
