PARISH PROJECTS

As good stewards of your generosity, the Facilities Team provides you regular updates on St. Matthew campus projects, improvements, ongoing initiatives and enhancements.

Last week, we mentioned the wide range of projects planned for the summer break. We wanted to share a few of those projects our community can look forward to next year.

The Hutta kitchen is the largest and most needed initiative we have planned, thanks to your support through the Bishop's Annual Appeal. In the coming weeks, we will provide additional detail and regular status reports.

The rest of our projects focus on maintenance issues and better use of space in our school. This year we are adding a Pre-K class to allow more families to participate in a quality Catholic education. Converting a classroom for these little ones includes adding room darkening blinds, small furniture, cots, and rugs. We welcome all of our new families.

The school library will be configured to support two teaching and conversation areas to better utilize the space. We are giving the Hutta stage a facelift by removing old radiators and adding shelving and racks to more efficiently store props and costumes. The art room will be receiving sink and lighting upgrades. Around the playground, there are still pergolas to be built, railings to be painted, equipment to be touched up and a couple of trees to be planted. A fence will be added along the east side of the property to better control access to the playground from the surrounding neighborhood. The rest of the school will receive a deep cleaning.

We will continue work on the Sanctuary beautification project by completing the Apse area and starting work on the latticework murals. The St. Anthony Room walls and floors will be painted and refinished.

We are excited to bring you these updates and we welcome suggestions for facilities improvement. Please contact George Harvey at gharvey@stmatthew.net.
