Their mission is to help pregnant women choose life for their babies, have healthier pregnancies, become better parents, and take the first steps to self-sufficiency. They do this by providing pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, counseling, initial material support, and parenting classes - along with other services.

Also, our memories include Army Private First Class Harrison James Meyer, nephew of our Deacon Joe Meyer (Maureen) who died in 2003 and Army Specialist Donald "DJ" Wheeler, brother of St. Matthew Cub Scout mom Mrs. Bernadette McNeil (Paul) who also died in 2003. Our Marine and three Soldiers were killed in Iraq. We remember their sacrifice. Though the St. Matthew Boy Scout Troop 317 and Cub Scout Pack 317 were not able to hold their annual November ceremony this year at the Peace Memorial due to the virus, we honor their memory. PARISH PROJECTS

As good stewards of your generosity, the Facilities Team is pleased to provide you regular updates on St. Matthew campus projects, improvements, and ongoing initiatives providing a safe, healthy, and prayerful environment.

As we all try to focus on the coming Christmas season during this first week of Advent, the health of our community becomes the top concern of the Facilities Team. Last week, Franklin County went purple, the school experienced their third case of COVID-19, the church was closed to all non-liturgical activities, and we celebrated Thanksgiving. Interesting times.

Our team has been working tirelessly this year on countless projects, parish improvements, maintenance issues, and disinfecting – disinfecting – disinfecting. As the year ends and team members are taking some time off, the remaining team members have one job – making our campus as safe as possible for our students, staff and parishioners. We will be doubling our cleaning and disinfecting processes. Because school access is limited to students and staff, we welcome anyone wishing to volunteer to help in the church.

Last week, we started upgrading the locks in the school enabling our teachers and staff to lock down the school without leaving their classrooms or offices. After routine maintenance issues are addressed, we will be working down a list of electrical upgrades in the school.

Christmas planning continues. We want to safely accommodate all those wishing to celebrate Mass with us in person. As the spread of COVID-19 continues to escalate, we plan to live stream all Christmas Eve and Christmas Day Masses. When we reach capacity in the Sanctuary on Christmas Eve, the Parish Activity Center will be set up to stream the Masses live and offer Communion of Consecrated Hosts from the Sanctuary Masses.
