# IN OUR PARISH

#### HOLY COMMUNION - DO WE LET HIM CHANGE US?

As we began our First Holy Communion Masses last weekend, I couldn't help but to think about my own First Holy Communion in my small farm hometown of Philo, IL. I received my First Holy Communion with four other First Communicants because that is just how tiny my hometown parish is! It was special, intimate, and exciting...dressing up and celebrating that great day. I don't remember much else on that day besides my heart thumping nerves of doing something totally new.

What I DO remember though is the preparation for receiving Jesus in the Eucharist. I remember the small musty room my four other classmates and I would go to each week at what we called CCD. The five of us would gather around a little table with our catechist and family-friend, Mr. Koberlein. I remember the importance he put on WHO we were receiving and even the small little "throne" we'd be making for Jesus to be placed on when receiving Communion: put our left hand over the right, nice and sturdy - high enough for the priest to place Jesus very easily on our hands. I remember the importance placed on my "AMEN" and how much we practiced this because my "AMEN" was declaring that I believed, that I was confirming: "YES! I believe I am receiving the Body of Christ!" I didn't know it then, but these little things I remember, these little pieces of my journey with our Catholic faith were only the beginning of what He had in store for my life. Through these small acts of preparation: the throne of my hands for God, my declaration of AMEN and all that was stressed as important, holy, and necessary to know for my First Holy Communion...it was all so that I could begin to recognize that Jesus would literally enter into my body and change me; if I made Him and His precious Body and Blood important in my life, if I could begin to recognize at a young age that He was the greatest and most precious gift in my week and in my day to day - then the way I viewed and lived my life would forever change for the best. And it has! What a Savior we have and what glorious gifts He has given us, especially the gift of Himself in the Eucharist.

Do you remember your First Holy Communion? How you prepared, where you were, or what you were feeling? If you don't, that's ok. I know that many people actually don't remember it....but the bigger question is this: have you let Jesus in the Eucharist change you? REALLY change you? Have we allowed the gift of His Body and Blood to transform our lives and live *radically* different than others? Lord, help us all to receive you and be radically changed!

# PARISH PROJECTS

As good stewards of your generosity, the Facilities Team is pleased to provide you regular updates on St. Matthew campus projects, improvements, and ongoing initiatives providing a safe, healthy, and prayerful environment.

Early last week, we started checking the school air conditioning units and changing filters; until the snow came and we had to move indoors. We will perform preventative maintenance and filter changes on the church units as updated control boards are installed for our new HVAC management system.

We are currently planning for the next phase of the Sanctuary beautification with the selection of new gothic style LED lights for the Sanctuary. We will have pictures available during this year's Bishop's Annual Appeal. The Gathering Space lights will also be retrofitted with LEDs. After an exhaustive search, we are evaluating several options, comparing size, uniformity of light, and color. The current lights are compact fluorescent bulbs which are hot, not energy efficient and expensive to replace

As more people are returning to Mass, we are exploring ways to increase our safe seating capacity. Our Sunday 10:00 a.m. Mass is consistently the most attended; the other weekend Masses have plenty of space for distancing.

The Facilities Team has provided daily Mass streaming now for over a year. We are considering only streaming Sunday Masses during the summer, then moving back to daily Mass streams in late August. The need for additional volunteers to help with streaming is a major factor in this decision. To make it easier for our stream team, we are also simplifying the process with less graphics and single camera angles. We appreciate your kind understanding as we work with limited resources and a lot of projects to accomplish this summer.


