

PARISH PROJECTS

Given the generosity of our parishioners, the Facilities Team is pleased to provide regular updates on St. Matthew campus projects, improvements, and ongoing initiatives to provide a safe, healthy, and prayerful environment.

After cleaning, disinfecting and reconfiguring cafeteria seating, our students returned to school this past week. As a precaution, we have doubled the spacing between students during lunch and have suspended many extracurricular activities. Our hope is to restart these activities slowly and systematically as we continue to monitor the health of our students.

Extra attention has also been given to church disinfecting as part of a campus wide effort. HVAC filters are being checked more often and we are bringing in more outside air to make the environment as clean as possible.

The Facilities Team appreciates your kind comments on the Nativity and Christmas decorations. Our Nativity figures were originally produced in the early 1920s. After displaying them in 2019, your contributions made it possible to restore them to their current beauty. The stable is built from 125-year-old timbers recovered during restoration of St. Mary Church, German Village. The time and care spent on our display is justified by the enjoyment it brings and as a reminder of the season.

The grandmother of 3-year-old Lydia shared the wonderment her granddaughter experienced this Christmas. Her first encounter was in an empty Sanctuary a couple days before Christmas. We invited her to take a closer look at the Nativity. As she studied the Nativity, she observed, "Jesus is missing." We assured her Jesus would arrive Christmas. After some contemplation in the pew next to the Nativity, her return was inevitable. After Christmas when she came back with her grandma, "He IS there! Jesus is in the manger." She then found the Wise Men making their way to the Nativity... and the star over the manger, "WOW." She again sat and studied the display. Lydia was heard later, "Mommy, what presents did the kings bring to Jesus?"

COMPUTER CYBER SECURITY FOR EVERYDAY PEOPLE -

Learn how to protect yourself in the Cyber World. Fellow parishioners Anthony & Allen Perk of XLN SYSTEMS, will explain, in non-technical terms, how to recognize Phishing Scams from emails and the phone. Other subjects to be discussed include "passphrases" (instead of passwords), freezing your credit, the Internet of Things-loT, and banking online more safely. Past attendees have stated this is very worthwhile and very timely.
