#### PRAYING THE PRAYER TO ST. MICHAEL AFTER MASS

I do not ask that you take them out of the world but that you keep them from the evil one. (John 17:15)

Beginning with the Sunday Masses on **June 25-26**, our parish will begin praying the Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel after all Sunday and weekday Masses. Once the Mass has ended and the priest has given the final blessing and dismissal, we will say this prayer together, asking for the intercession of St. Michael to protect us from the evil one and to heal our country and our community from strife and division. Following the prayer, we will recite the Divine Praises or sing the recessional hymn, as usual.

The tradition of praying this prayer after Mass began in the late 19th century when Pope Leo XIII saw demons flying over St. Peter's Basilica. The prayer acknowledges the very real presence of evil in the world and our need for protection from the evil one. As our world, our country, and even our personal relationships are under more and more strain from hatred, division, anger, and lack of peace, Fr. Ted and Fr. Steve have asked that our parish unite in our efforts to reject Satan and the brokenness that he brings to our lives. The prayer can be found in the *Lumen Christi* missal on page 1085.


Much of these first two weeks after school breaks for the summer is spent on furniture moving and preparation of areas for construction. We are also taking advantage of this time to get work done in the Rectory garage including repairs to walls and floor. When completed the entire garage, ceiling to floor will get a fresh a coat of paint.

The largest single school project this summer is creating a couple of offices, a testing/tutor room, and a reading room out of the library as we expand our curriculum and number of teachers and tutors. To accomplish this, the upper level of the library must be packed up and moved during construction. We also had to relocate the teachers' resource area, which will be conveniently located in the main school. We are also removing a wall to add a conference room to facilitate teacher and parent meetings; something our school has needed. Materials for these projects will start coming in next week on an as-needed basis.

Last week, the Diocese made a courtesy visit to see how we have enhanced our security camera system and to discuss safety protocols for next year considering recent events at other schools across the country. They also wanted to know about our access controls.

#### PRO-LIFE CORNER

Live the Gospel of

During the civil unrest and rioting of the 1960's, Bishop Fulton Sheen presented a show entitled "Where are you going, America?" During this program, Bishop

Sheen contrasted the revolution that our country was founded upon, versus the revolution that our country was experiencing 50 years ago. The two are quite different. It is amazing how well he was describing our current times, and his prophetic insight into what the unrest of the 60's would lead to. This video is only 20 minutes long and is well worth watching https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gy6VtXVcGFw.

One of the key points that Bishop Sheen makes in this program is that our founding fathers believed that we were endowed with unalienable rights to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness, from God. The government's role is to protect these rights, not grant them. The right to life is stated in the Declaration of Independence and in the 14th Amendment "no state shall enforce any law ... which will deprive any person of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor deny to any person the equal protection of the law." The Supreme Court, in *Roe vs Wade*, completely sidestepped this principle, by declaring that a "fetus" is a "potential life" not a person.

If, as anticipated, *Roe vs Wade* is overturned, there will be an uproar of verbal and physical protest proclaiming that "reproductive rights" have been violated. Bishop Sheen gives his solution to the moral decay represented by these protests, at the end of his program.


