PARISH PROJECTS

Given the generosity of our parishioners, the Facilities Team is pleased to provide regular updates on St. Matthew campus projects, improvements, and ongoing initiatives to provide a safe, healthy, and prayerful environment.

This week, we are about halfway through the summer break as all eyes are on a very aggressive detailed list of tasks. Our major construction projects were drywalled over the holiday weekend. Finishing the drywall, painting, trimming, electrical, and lighting can not be rushed. We still need time to clean up and reconfigure the library in a more open and flexible configuration.

Other projects that are just getting started include five printer stations and three more CleverTouch smartboard installations; all funded by grants. Cleaning supplies, wax, and equipment were delivered last week so we can start classroom cleaning. We are only about 20% through the teacher classroom maintenance lists.

Outstanding grant applications include WiFi enhancements/ expansion and more water bottle filling stations. If we are awarded the funds, these projects would be added to our summer projects.


Church Sanctuary lighting remains a hot topic. We have worked through supply chain issues, solved controller compatibility problems, expanded the project to include updating all ceiling track lighting systems, and adding recessed light replacement to LEDs, without increasing the total cost of the project. The last hurtle is selection of a licensed electrical contractor willing and able to assist with installation. As you know, the building trades are extremely busy. We need help to get this project completed.

PRO-LIFE CORNER

Live the Gospel of

On the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Supreme Court has officially overturned *Roe vs Wade* in a 5 to 4 decision. This is a great moment

for the Pro-Life movement and there is a lot of work to do at the state level to eliminate or restrict abortion. Based on the Heartbeat laws that have already been passed, we know that legally restricting abortion saves the lives of unborn children. There are 26 states that either have, or will have, laws banning or restricting abortion.

In Ohio, there is already a law signed by Governor DeWine, that prohibits abortion after 6 weeks, with no exception for rape and incest. The law further requires aborted babies be buried or cremated, prevents medication abortions via telemedicine, and requires abortion clinics to have written transfer agreements with a hospital – which will likely cause 2 clinics in Southeast Ohio to close. This law could not go into effect until *Roe vs Wade* was overturned.

There is also pending legislation that would ban doctors from performing medication or surgical abortions and establish a fourth-degree felony for violators. If passed, this would effectively ban all abortions in Ohio. The Governor's race this year is extremely important. The incumbent is very pro-life and wants to ban abortion in Ohio, the democratic candidate is a strong abortion advocate and promises to veto any legislation restricting abortion.


