Easter duty — All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season, from the first Sunday of Lent (February 26) to Trinity Sunday (June 4), unless it is fulfilled for a just cause at some other time during the year. After having attained the age of discretion, each of the faithful is bound by an obligation faithfully to confess serious sins at least once a year.

PARISH PROJECTS

Given the generosity of our parishioners, the Facilities Team is pleased to provide regular updates on St. Matthew campus projects, improvements, and on-going initiatives to provide a safe, healthy, and prayerful environment for you and our children.

As we have all prepared our hearts for Holy Week this Lent, as has the Facilities Team prepared the church for the Easter celebration. An eight week effort to install new lights in the Sanctuary was only one of many tasks intent on serving our parish.

With the largest room in our house fitted with decorative highly efficient LED lights and spots, we moved to converting all the church fluorescent fixtures to LEDs. Compared to the 4,500 bulbs changed out in the school three years ago, changing 600 fluorescent tubes in the church is much more manageable. Starting with the lights that are on the most, office common areas and lower-level halls, we then moved to the 120 bulbs in the St. Anthony Room. After those high use areas, the remaining offices and meeting rooms will be done over time. Interesting to note, we have not changed any bulbs at school in the three years following the conversion. Not only are we saving \$2,000 per month in energy costs during the school year, but we also don't have the costs of replacing over 1,000 burned out bulbs every summer. With major energy cost increases on the horizon, our efforts are timely.

PRO-LIFE CORNER



The Alliance for Hippocratic Medicine (AHM), a coalition of over 30,000 Christian healthcare professionals, has

filed a lawsuit in a Texas federal district court to overrule the FDA's approval of mifepristone, the first of the two pills used in a chemical abortion. The judge in this court is pro-life, the next court of appeal is conservative, and from there it would go to the Supreme Court. If successful, mifepristone would be banned nationwide. There is a good chance this effort will be successful. It is estimated that over 50% of the annual 940,000 abortions are done using chemical abortions.

The basis of this lawsuit is that the FDA inappropriately used their "fast-track" process to approve this drug in 2000. This process is supposed to be used for drugs that treat life threatening illnesses and have therapeutic benefits. Mifepristone has neither and you cannot define pregnancy as an illness. In addition, the FDA did not properly investigate the complications caused by mifepristone, and has removed almost all the safeguards on this drug over the last 7 years. Responsible studies of the use of the abortion pill have shown that 20% of the women have medical complications, and in some cases even death.

The abortion industry is quite alarmed over the potential success of this lawsuit. Their fallback plan is to attempt more surgical abortions, though the staffing and capacity in this space has diminished in the last 10 years; or do misoprostol only chemical abortions. Misoprostol is the second drug of the abortion pill package, which induces labor – the first pill is what kills the baby. This approach creates another set of complications and has a failure rate of 25%, requiring a surgical abortion or clean up. But getting mifepristone banned would be a major step in the right direction of curbing chemical abortions. Of course, the biggest step would be for the distressed mother to have a change of heart and chose Life.

CHARITABLE WORKS MINISTRY NEWS

Recap of February 2023 – Another busy month for CWM! The St. Matthew Charitable Works Ministry provided an estimated 10,230 meals to 682 individuals in 231 households within the greater Gahanna community during the month of February. We continue to see increasing demand from large families. Our food costs continue to be high as inventories at the Mid-Ohio Food Bank decline and we purchase more at retail. Although, our costs were lower this month due to the generosity of the St. Matthew School and families, who donated about 2,000 pounds of canned goods as part of their "Super Bowl Collection" effort. 
