## PRO-LIFE CORNER

Live the  
Gospel of *Life*

On **Wednesday, May 24**, we will be sponsoring a presentation by diocesan experts on the proposed amendment to our Ohio Constitution, entitled "The Right to Reproductive Freedom with Protections for Health and Safety." The presentation will be at **7:00 p.m.** in the St. Anthony Room. This meeting will present the facts on this amendment and what we can do to stop it. In summary, this amendment would legalize:

- Abortion through all 9 months of pregnancy – it claims to restrict abortion after "viability" but uses the health of the mother as an escape clause.
- Gender transformation medical procedures for minors.
- Override any laws requiring parental consent or notification for minors getting "reproductive services" such as abortion, contraception, fertility treatment, gender transformation, etc.

Gender transformation is not specifically mentioned in the proposed amendment but implied under the category of "reproductive decisions." Gender services has become the latest money maker for Planned Parenthood, climbing from 16,000 cases in 2020 to 260,000 in 2021.

There is a large, well organized, grassroots campaign underway to collect signatures from voters to put this amendment on the November ballot. Unfortunately, we expect this effort to be successful by the deadline of July 5. Their goal is to collect 700,000 signatures which is almost twice the number needed. The pro-abortion coalition behind this effort is well-funded and supported by out-of-state groups.

The May 24 presentation will help us to be well-informed about the content of this extreme amendment, able to explain it to others when the occasion arises, and emphasize the importance of voting against this amendment during an off-cycle election year – a time when many of us choose not to vote. But we need to make this year an exception.

**RECAP OF APRIL 2023 – A VERY busy month for CWM.** The St. Matthew Charitable Works Ministry provided an estimated **14,355** meals to **957** individuals (record) in **294** households (record) within the greater Gahanna community during the month of April. We continue to see increasing demand from large families (note the “Average Family Size” below). Our food costs continue to be high as we get less free/low cost food from Mid-Ohio Food Bank, and we purchase more at retail. Thank you for your continued support to those families who are experiencing difficult times through your financial support and volunteer efforts.
