#### PRO-LIFE CORNER



Happy Father's Day! Fatherhood has its origins in God, who chose to reveal Himself to us as Our Father, sending His only Son for the sake

of our salvation. Pope St. John Paul II stated that, "Fathers have a special role in revealing and reliving on earth the very fatherhood of God." The role of the father "is of unique and irreplaceable importance, it is both a biological and spiritual reality." Fathers are entrusted with the protection and defense of both mother and child and, in this way, in safeguarding the sanctity of human life.

Research shows that the absence of a father in the nuclear family can be devastating. Approximately 24 million children in the U.S. today are fatherless, which is 1 out of every 3 children. 85% of the incarcerated men grew up fatherless; 90% of high school dropouts are without a dad; and 75% of the adolescent patients in a substance abuse center are fatherless. These statistics are jarring and make us thankful for the families that have both a committed father and mother. In their unique roles, both provide the stability needed to raise children to be morally responsible.

The Church presents St. Joseph as the model for earthly and spiritual fatherhood. St. Joseph endured both unexpected and difficult circumstances, yet he remained faithful in providing care and protection to Jesus and Mary. Let us thank our fathers today for their efforts to represent, as best they could, the Fatherhood of God in our lives. St. Joseph, foster father of Jesus, pray for all fathers to continue to be faithful to their families.

#### PARISH PROJECTS

Given the generosity of our parishioners, the Facilities Team is pleased to provide updates on St. Matthew campus projects, repairs, improvements, and on-going initiatives to provide a safe, healthy, and prayerful environment for you and our children.

We apologize for the many inconveniences we have brought to the campus already this summer. We are dealing with compressed timeframes and must maximize efficiency on all projects. Most notable are the Sanctuary repairs and renovations. Moving daily Masses to the St. Anthony Room has helped labor utilization. Moving the initial construction phase to the back of the church to better understand the challenges has accelerated the learning curve. We are finding concealed roof and insulation issues which we are solving now to save time on later phases.

The other major, but much less costly project, is the assembly of playground equipment salvaged from the Lincoln HS construction. Dan Rannebarger, owner of Rannebarger Home Maintenance, has been contributing much time, effort, and equipment to the preparation of the site behind the school. Thank you to our 8th Grade graduating class for their Legacy Gift that has helped to offset the cost of the playground surface. We were first challenged with rock hard soil from the lack of rain and then delayed last week from days of downpours. The rain will ultimately help with bringing back the grass in the soccer field, but like they say, when you wish for rain, you must deal with the mud.

In the school, we are creating 600 square feet of storage for athletics, converting 400 square feet of open area into tutoring/ testing rooms while shuffling office space for additional teachers and tutors. The attention to continual improvement in our school will pay major dividends to the level of education we offer our students. Grants are again being utilized to standardize and increase the number of Smartboards in our school, supported by a grant funded Internet upgrade.

Service hours are available to help with cleaning outside windows, lockers, and lights. You can make a difference. Thank you for your consideration.







#### CHARITABLE WORKS MINISTRY NEWS

RECAP OF MAY 2023 – WOW! Another VERY busy month for CWM. If we thought the record number of families that we had in April was a lot, we had a nearly 20% increase in May! The St. Matthew Charitable Works Ministry provided an estimated 17,565 meals to 1,171 individuals (record) in 362 households (record) within the greater Gahanna community during the month of May. We continue to see increasing demand from large families. Our food costs continue to be high as we get less free/low cost food from Mid-Ohio Food Bank, and we purchase more at retail. Rather than the usual chart, the below graphs provide a much better view of the trends and increases dating back to January 2022. Thank you for your continued support to those families who are experiencing difficult times through your financial support and volunteer efforts.
