NOTES FROM THE CHOIR LOFT

In our Liturgical Calendar, we have once again entered the long stretch of Ordinary Time, from mid-June to the end of November. As we did last summer, our Communion Antiphon and verses will be the main music focus during Communion time. The refrain and page number from the pew missal will be on the hymn screens, inviting all to join in singing the refrain. The verses will be from Scripture, which allows us to meditate on the living and effective Word of God as we receive the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus in the Eucharist.

Receiving Communion is the most intimate time of our worship in the Mass, when Jesus comes to dwell in us. What should we do or how should we respond? While music aids in communion with our Savior, our own personal response is key. If we have ever wondered what to say in prayer or meditate on at this moment, recall that our faith is a gift of grace, for which we say: 'Lord, increase my faith! I believe; help my areas of unbelief!' We can also just talk with Him in our hearts, giving Him all of our cares and joys from the past week. Additionally, printed prayers toward the back of the pew missal, beginning around page 1000, can deepen our meditation. As we offer the Sacred Silence when the Communion procession ends, we listen for the Lord's response and resolve to grow closer to Him.

PRO-LIFE CORNER

Live the
Gospel of *Life*

Human trafficking is modern day slavery. It has become very pervasive and is said to be hidden in plain sight. It violates the sanctity, dignity, and fundamental rights of the human person. It is defined as "the recruitment, transportation, or holding of persons by means of force, fraud or coercion, for the purpose of exploitation." The exploitation is sexual (80%) or forced labor (20%), and even includes trafficking in newborn babies, women who can serve as surrogates, and organ harvesting. Worldwide, it is estimated to be a \$150 billion dollar business affecting 40 million victims. It is the fastest growing source of illegal profit for criminals because of its relatively low risk – victims are typically "lured" and not kidnapped – and high demand.

Surprisingly, Ohio is one of the top five states for trafficking in the U.S., and Columbus is one of the top 10 cities. The reason for this is that Ohio has both large urban centers and rural counties, a large transient and immigrant population, and five major highways with easy access to other states and Canada. In response to this, Ohio established in 2012 the Ohio Human Trafficking Task Force to coordinate efforts across 20 agencies to identify victims, prosecute human trafficking crimes, and to provide services and treatment for trafficking victims. In Ohio, 90% of the trafficking cases are sexual and involve women between the ages of 21-29.

The newly released movie, *The Sound of Freedom*, does an excellent job of portraying the victims of human trafficking without being graphic. It is based on the true story of a daring rescue to save children of this crime. The movie trailer is at this link <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Rt0kp4VW1cl> and the film is highly recommended. It stars Jim Caviezel, who played Christ in *The Passion of the Christ*.

PARISH PROJECTS

Given the generosity of our parishioners, the Facilities Team is pleased to provide updates on St. Matthew campus projects, repairs, improvements, and ongoing initiatives to provide a safe, healthy, and prayerful environment for you and our children during the summer break.

Significant progress has been made on the new playground and the Sanctuary. The new digital monument sign continues to move slowly through the Gahanna permitting process. A new project is starting to address drainage and water intrusion on the north end of the Sanctuary. This week bushes and flowers will be removed to lower the grade, so water drains away from church.

The new playground is almost finished utilizing equipment from the Gahanna HS site and Eighth Grade Legacy funds for the surface. The soccer field behind the school has been graded for better drainage. The only thing left is repairing irrigation and getting it seeded.

The northeast and north walls of the Sanctuary have been insulated, new mechanicals installed, and the drywall is going up. The plan is to finish those sections and get the pews back in place before moving to the south side of the Sanctuary.

In the coming weeks, outside projects include working on fence repair and painting. School projects include finishing several tutor rooms and a couple storage rooms. As we approach the halfway point of summer break, there is still much to be done.

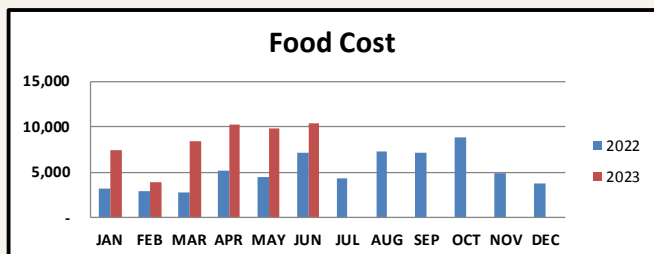
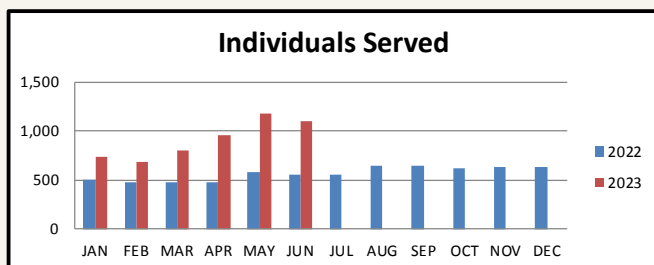
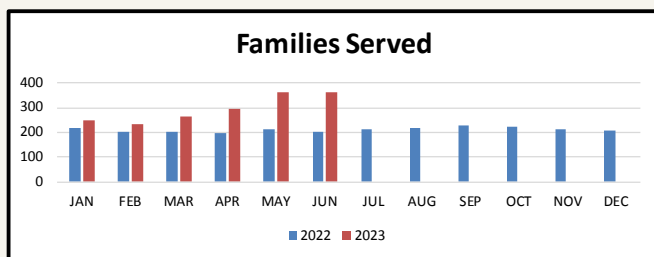

CHARITABLE WORKS MINISTRY NEWS

Recap of June 2023 – Another VERY busy month for CWM. We equaled our May record of 362 families served with an identical number of families served in June. The St. Matthew Charitable Works Ministry provided an estimated **16,425** meals to **1,095** individuals in **362** households within the greater Gahanna community during the month of June. We continue to see increasing demand from large families. Our food costs continue to be high as we get less free/low cost food from Mid-Ohio Food Bank, and we purchase more at retail. The below graphs provide a view of the trends and increases dating back to January 2022. Thank you for your continued support to those families who are experiencing difficult times through your financial support and volunteer efforts.
