SCRIPTURE 102 – A NEW TESTAMENT STUDY FOR THE FALL

Scripture 102 is a unique Bible Study on the New Testament that digs deeper into Scripture unlike any other. Fr. Sebastian Carnazzo from the Institute of Catholic Culture follows up from the Scripture 101 class by using typology, that is, seeing how the Old Testament is fulfilled in the New. He shows us the errors in the religions that have strayed off course all the while helping us to understand how knowing the Bible and salvation history will assist us with the culture we live in today.

Scripture 102 may be a little difficult for those who are new to taking Bible Studies, but Fr. Sebastian takes you step by step as he reads what he considers are important passages in a particular book of the Bible and, in turn, looks at a corresponding book to compare its similar themes. He is especially remarkable on how he intertwines the book of Acts with the epistles of Paul and the Catholic letters to give a timeline of when these letters were written and why. History comes alive with this study.

Fr. Sebastian also is quite the comedian and keeps the class laughing. It is NEVER boring! He is a Melkite Rite priest and he sometimes explains differences between the Latin and Eastern Catholic churches, which is fascinating, while emphasizing that we are One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church.

PARISH PROJECTS

Given the generosity of our parishioners, the Facilities Team is pleased to provide updates on St. Matthew campus projects, repairs, improvements, and ongoing initiatives to provide a safe, healthy, and prayerful environment for you and our children during the summer break.

The application for our new electronic monument sign on Havens Corners Road is finally going in front of the Gahanna Planning Commission on Wednesday, July 26 at 7:00 p.m. (Gahanna City Hall, Council Chambers, 200 S. Hamilton Road). Over the last couple of months, we have been answering questions and clarifying our sign request. After public discussion on Wednesday, the Planning Commission will make a motion to approve, deny, or postpone, and a vote will be taken. Wish us luck.

The Sanctuary project continues to move forward and take shape. The final look is coming to life as the first section and end walls near completion. Insulation issues are being addressed as the church becomes more energy efficient. Drainage issues are also being addressed with the lowering of the grade around the front of the church.

The installation of a new playground behind the school has been completed and received much activity during the Festival last weekend. We are now looking at solutions to the deteriorating 20-year-old surface of our original playground. If we replace the surface, it will give us an opportunity to add a couple slides also salvaged from the Lincoln High School site.

The PAC gym storage areas have been modified, adding another 1,000 square feet of storage space. The additional space has created space for three more tutoring and meeting rooms in different areas of the school. We are now installing windows in all remaining solid interior doors on the new rooms and all student accessible storage rooms.

PRO-LIFE CORNER



The president of Susan B.
Anthony Pro-Life America,
Marjorie Dannenfelser, has
made an interesting observation
on the key reason that most

people would respond to, and vote NO on the November 7 abortion amendment. Most of us would start with stating that this amendment would legalize abortion through all 9 months of pregnancy. But many people are so saturated with the propaganda of abortion advocates that they are left with the feeling that "abortion is probably ok early on, and that decision should be made by the woman." But Marjorie thinks that what gets people's attention is the attack on parental rights this amendment represents.


The amendment states that "every individual has a right to make and carry out one's own reproductive decisions ... the State shall not, directly or indirectly, burden, penalize, prohibit, interfere with, or discriminate against ... an individual's voluntary exercise of this right." There is no distinction made between an adult or a minor, therefore a person of any age can make this decision without "interference" from state parental consent laws. This would include decisions on abortion and transgender medical procedures — which are implied in the category of reproductive decisions.


While many parents may have "neutral" feelings about abortion, it is a far different matter for them to realize that this amendment nullifies their right to be involved in their children's decisions regarding abortion or gender transformation. The ACLU person who was the primary drafter of this amendment, admitted in an interview, that this amendment would make the current Ohio consent laws unenforceable. The ACLU has an entire page on their website advocating for the elimination of parental consent laws, stating that "mandating parental involvement in a teen's abortion decision can prevent teens from getting the abortions they want, it can lead to teens suffering the physical, emotional, educational, economic, and social costs of teenage childbearing." The amendment would also protect an "influencer" who talked a teenager into getting an abortion or gender transformation, or even drove them to the clinic. A vast majority of people would agree that this not the kind of constitutional right we want to establish in Ohio.



CHARITABLE WORKS MINISTRY NEWS

Recap of June 2023 – Another VERY busy month for CWM. We equaled our May record of 362 families served with an identical number of families served in June. The St. Matthew Charitable Works Ministry provided an estimated 16,425 meals to 1,095 individuals in 362 households within the greater Gahanna community during the month of June.
