SCRIPTURE 102 – A NEW TESTAMENT STUDY FOR THE FALL

Scripture 102 is a unique Bible Study on the New Testament that digs deeper into Scripture unlike any other. Fr. Sebastian Carnazzo from the Institute of Catholic Culture follows up from the Scripture 101 class by using typology, that is, seeing how the Old Testament is fulfilled in the New. He shows us the errors in the religions that have strayed off course all the while helping us to understand how knowing the Bible and salvation history will assist us with the culture we live in today.

Scripture 102 may be a little difficult for those who are new to taking Bible Studies, but Fr. Sebastian takes you step-by-step as he reads what he considers are important passages in a particular book of the Bible and, in turn, looks at a corresponding book to compare its similar themes. He is especially remarkable on how he intertwines the book of Acts with the epistles of Paul and the Catholic letters to give a timeline of when these letters were written and why. History comes alive with this study.

Fr. Sebastian also is guite the comedian and keeps the class laughing. It is NEVER boring! He is a Melkite Rite priest and he sometimes explains differences between the Latin and Eastern Catholic churches, which is fascinating, while emphasizing that we are One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church.

PARISH PROJECTS

Given the generosity of our parishioners, the Facilities Team is pleased to provide updates on St. Matthew campus projects, repairs, improvements, and ongoing initiatives to provide a safe, healthy, and prayerful environment for you and our children as they prepare to return from summer break.

Our dedicated teaching staff have already started preparing their classrooms in anticipation of their first official days this week. The Facilities Team continues final preparations for our students' return.

Some of the final details last week included installation of more Smart Boards in new tutor rooms, additional Internet access points, a couple more cameras on school entries, final placement of furniture, uniform sales, delivery of school supplies, and cleaning up the campus grounds.

We still have some safety related installations to complete, including sidewalk and playground repairs, fence repairs and painting. The Sanctuary is not ready for an all-school Mass, but we anticipate it will be in time for Bishop Earl's visit on September 21.

The Sanctuary remains the largest unfinished campus project. As the inside continues to progress despite some equipment challenges, the outside roof and foundation issues continue to stretch our resources. We have been walking a fine line between making urgent repairs, designing, and implementing long-term solutions, without impacting the original project timelines. The inside must be completed in a timely manner, and the outside must be ready for winter. We appreciate your continued patience and enduring the inconveniences of our construction zone. We will continue to spend whatever effort is necessary to keep weekend Masses in the Sanctuary. It takes a dedicated team to reassemble the Altar, set up sound and to make sure you are not sitting in drywall dust. Thank you for your attendance.

PRO-LIFE CORNER



The Church dedicates the month of August to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, and the highlight of this month is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the

Blessed Virgin Mary. This feast day reminds us that our destiny should be to follow in Mary's footsteps to share, body and soul, in the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. It is a testimony that God did not create life to be discarded.

Contrary to the secular view represented in the "Right to Reproductive Freedom" amendment, Mary's Assumption demonstrates for us that God loves human life from conception to its natural end. Mary models for us protection for the unborn, support for parents raising their children, and respect for the person created by God, including their gender. The "Reproductive Freedom" amendment violates all of these principles. All of us have a part in seeing that this amendment is defeated in the November election through our vote, prayer, and interaction with others.

Voting NO on this amendment is straightforward given its denial of the truth on fundamental church teaching on abortion, parental guardianship, and gender changing treatments. For prayer, the Ohio Conference of Bishops is encouraging all Catholics to join in a 54-day Rosary Novena beginning on September 15 – the feast day of Our Lady of Sorrows. To discuss with other people why this amendment is so counter to basic Christian values, educate yourself on the highlights of what is stated, and what is subtly implied. An objective analysis which does not take long to read has been compiled by Greater Columbus Right to Life at this link https://www.gcrtl.org/uploads/4/7/1/2/4712557/extreme_abortion_two_pager.pdf. The analysis is only two pages, and it covers the amendment, current Ohio law, and the implications and dangers of the ballot language.

Dear St. Matthew Community,

As children are a great gift to families, so are they a great gift to our community. They remind us of the wonder, energy, curiosity, and joy of life. Most of all they remind us that Jesus calls us to be like them in their innocence and purity. They, like all of us, have a place at the Eucharistic table as members of the Body of Christ. We not only welcome them to Mass; we want them there.

When children are in Mass, even as babies and toddlers, they build a habit of faith. They see their parents worshiping with a community of faith and they, themselves, receive graces and blessings merely by their presence before the Eucharist.

The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Catholic faith; it unifies our Christian witness. Throughout the Gospels, Jesus frequently refers to children as not only acceptable participants in Christian witness, but ideal ones. Children are a vital part of the Christian community, and when they are in a separate location during Mass, the Body of Christ in a sense is divided and our children are missing out on the graces available to them at Mass.



Because we value our children and their place in our faith community, our nursery will no longer be staffed during Mass beginning September 2023. Rather, we are expanding our faith formation opportunities for little ones and their families to build upon the foundations begun at Mass.







RECAP OF JULY 2023 – Another busy month for CWM. Although we did not set a new record for July, we still served 346 families. The St. Matthew Charitable Works Ministry provided an estimated **15,585** meals to **1,039** individuals in **346** households within the greater Gahanna community during the month of July. We continue to see increasing demand from large families. Our food costs continue to be high as we get less free/low cost food from Mid-Ohio Food Bank, and we purchase more at retail. The below graphs provide a view of the trends and increases dating back to January 2022. Thank you for your continued support to those families who are experiencing difficult times through your financial support and volunteer efforts.




