PRO-LIFE CORNER

The Ohio March for Life last Friday, October 6, drew an even larger crowd than last year. It was estimated that over 5,000 people attended. The opening prayer was led by Bishop Fernandes, who has been very outspoken in urging the defeat of Issue 1 ("reproductive rights" amendment). In an interview with the Catholic News Agency, Bishop Fernandes stated that "Issue 1 will be absolutely devastating for Ohio, worse than what we had under *Roe vs. Wade*. This is more than allowing abortion up to the moment of birth, its broad language could be used to remove any limits on gender selection, chemical castration, transgender surgeries, and gender reassignment on minors – all without parental notification." At the Cathodics "To say 'no' to the killing of innocents and to say 'yes' to the gift of life."

One of the dangers of Issue 1 that has not received much attention is that it opens the door for telehealth abortion pill distribution. Currently, this is restricted in Ohio, and in-person doctor appointments are required. The use of telehealth for abortion is a rapidly growing trend, and in fact, there are six states which now allow "out-of-staters" to use this method. Michigan dropped their restrictions on telehealth abortion once their abortion amendment was passed, for in-state only (for now). Allowing telehealth abortion not only puts women at more risk for unforeseen complications, but it also becomes even more onerous when allowing minors to use this method and not notifying parents.

Recent polling data indicates that once people are aware of the dangers and extremes of Issue 1, many will vote against it. If not informed, and left to rely on the deceptive pro-abortion ads, many will vote for it. We need to cast our vote against Issue 1 and educate our family and friends to see why they should do the same. As Bishop Fernandes concluded, we should not only vote, but more importantly, "we should not underestimate the power of prayer and the Rosary in particular in the defense of human life."



Access control into the church building during school activities and after hours are being addressed. There are opportunities to enhance outside lighting, additional playground barriers, enhanced fire and emergency alarms, and a redesign of the school entrance with additional secured vestibules and lobby. 


CHARITABLE WORKS MINISTRY NEWS

 - · 375 families served
 - 1,143 individuals served in those families (Nearly double what we did a year ago)
