Youth: Ask yourself what possessions you can live without. Once you decide, give away what you don't need to someone



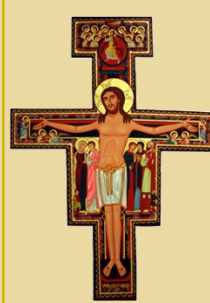

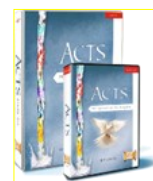
Revelation: The Kingdom Yet to Come

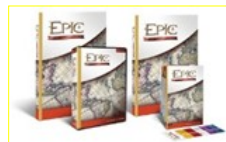
You will learn what all the mysterious figures and images of Revelation present, as well as what will happen during the Second Coming of Christ, what has already happened, and what is happening now in salvation history.
