

Enrollment is now open for high school youth group, Element 4:12, Confirmation Year One and middle school youth group, EDGE.



Our main goal in youth ministry is to provide a safe space for teens to strengthen their faith life, talk about relevant issues, educate them about the Bible and Church teachings as well as prepare them for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Element 4:12/Confirmation Year One is open to freshman-seniors in high school. We meet most Sundays from 6pm-7:30pm in the Annex, which is located next to the BBQ on the blacktop.


