Message from Fr. Rick



THE LENTEN JOURNEY

How is prayer during Lent any different from our attention to prayer during the rest of the year? Lent is an opportunity to be more mindful of repentance. For some this takes the form of devotional prayer such as praying the rosary or meditating on the Psalms each day—to become a living sacrifice of praise to God. These devotional practices help us to reflect more carefully on our relationship to God and one another with an eye toward selflessness. Such practices can help us realize a deeper understanding of our role in proclaiming the Good News.

When you fast, how does it differ from dieting? Many Catholics may see Lent as an opportunity to lose weight. The ancient practice of fasting makes one more mindful of our longing for God. Limiting consumption of certain food or drink helps us demonstrate our solidarity with others that are deprived of food when it's limited or insufficient. Fasting sharpens our sensibility and gratitude for the blessing of food and those who make it available to us from the work of their hands.


How often do you encounter others in need? What is our attitude toward such a person during this time of repentance? When we are able to reach out to others by contributing to their wellbeing, we are fulfilling the Gospel message; "Whenever you did this for the least of mine, you did it for me." The practice of giving generously allows us to identity with those who go without and helps us to recognize that any of us could find ourselves impoverished.

Lent is a period to meditate on the paschal mystery—Jesus' death and resurrection. What does it mean to rise from the dead? For Christians, we imagine death not so much as the end of existence or annihilation, rather we understand death as a transition from the life we know now to new life in Christ. Non-existence does not sit well with us even while we know that all things must pass. This kind of wisdom may be paradoxical, but the richness of our faith will help us avoid pitfalls and disappointments that are a result of our inattention to understanding how God is calling us to discipleship in Christ.

To reject idolatry in all its forms and to clear our minds of falsehoods and selfish pride will allow us to experience the love flowing from the living and eternal God. When any of us experience God's love then we are called to love our neighbor as ourselves. We hunger for what is truly eternal though we don't fully understand eternity. What Jesus offers is wisdom, not wealth or power. The call to understanding, solidarity, and identity with the poor is the path that leads to the encounter of the divine. The answers we seek can be found in our willingness to abandon ourselves to the Father of Jesus. What Jesus models requires us to draw on God's love so as to practice what we believe in faith by loving one another as Jesus loves us. May each of us make the best of this Lent by turning away from sin and embrace the gospel message.



INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

How is your Lent going so far? In changing the circumstances and order of our lives a bit, perhaps we can hear God's voice more clearly and drink more deeply of graced moments we experience. Having God as a friend always involves several things. First, there is God's call. We become attuned to the echo of God's voice in the depth of our souls calling and beckoning us to listen. Second, there is a request. We begin to see that God asks us to do certain things, to order our lives a particular way, and become more intentional in the choices we make. Third, there is trust. Do we trust this call and request? Trust commits us to the relationship and makes a claim on who we are. Finally, we are asked to act. We find ourselves acting, not in the way we used to, but in a transformed, more enlightened way. Things seem clearer and all that is around us shines with the brilliance of God's presence. God's call came through a cloud, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him," This is the call and the request. Can we give God our trust and do as God asks?

Stewardship Reflection on Lectionary Readings February 28, 2021 - Second Sunday of Lent

GN 22:1-2, 9a, 10-13, 15-18; PS 116:10, 15, 16-17, 18-19; ROM 8:31b-34; MK 9:2-10

Today's readings are a powerful testimony to God's profound love for each one of us. It is a reminder for us, as Christian stewards, to surrender all that we have to the Gracious Giver.


The First Reading from Genesis is the infamous story of God putting Abraham to the test. God commands Abraham to offer his son, Isaac, to the Lord as a sacrifice. Abraham obeys the Lord. Yet, a messenger of the Lord cries out at the last moment to stop him. Because of Abraham's faithfulness and surrender to the Lord, he is blessed abundantly.

We can only imagine how Abraham felt, offering the life of his son, not understanding why, but blindly obeying. Yet, Abraham's response of total surrender to God's plan is a testament to trust in God's deep love for us. As Christian stewards, we are called to surrender all to the Lord — our time, our talents and even our material possessions. We should willingly give God our entire lives with the confidence that He will take care of us.

St. Paul echoes this message so beautifully in our Second Reading. He says, "He who did not spare his own Son but handed him over for us all, how will he not also give us everything else along with him?" God loves us so much that He gave us His only Son who suffered, died and rose for us. He has given us His very best. Can we not entrust our entire lives to Him knowing He will continue to pour out His love on us?

As we continue our journey through Lent, let us reflect on God's profound love for us.


