



ABOUT THE CHANGE IN MASS SCHEDULE

Starting Wednesday, September 1, the weekday Mass will start one hour earlier, at 8:30 A.M. rather than 9:30 A.M. It is my understanding that the time of the weekday Mass, originally scheduled for 7:30 A.M., was changed last year to 9:30 A.M. because Mass took place outside and it was too cold to start earlier in the morning. The primary reason for changing the Mass time to 8:30 A.M. is to make it possible, when permissible, for the students at our parish school to worship with the members of our parish community who attend the daily Mass. We are all one community and our worship together will be an important sign of our unity. Since school begins at 8 A.M., the change in Mass time will also allow school parents to attend Mass after dropping off their children. Live streaming of the daily Mass will continue for those unable to come to church.






