

# Did you know ...

- » We have 2,200 registered families (additional 1,300 not registered)
- » 300 households use envelopes (993 households receive envelopes)
- » 281 households have signed up to use Online Giving
- » An average of 474 households support ADA
- » 602 families support the Centennial Campaign
- » An average of 1,350 people attend mass each weekend
- » 1,547 people in our email database
- \$17,250 is the average weekly Sunday Collection
   (\$2,800/wk Online Giving) We raised approx.
   \$300,000 through Special Collections (20 special

collections of which Catholic Charities and St. Mary's School is included)

- » There are 56 paid Parish and School employees
- » We have pledges over \$7.1 million towards the Centennial Campaign
- Over 1,000 of you volunteer for one or more events (like the Country Fair), activities, programs, outreach and/or liturgies (eucharistic ministers, lectors, etc) for the parish and school.
- » Your support maintains the facilities and
  - added a new Roof on the church\* \$180
  - created a beautiful Courtyard \$130
  - replaced the church A/C & Heating unit \$350
  - install a new church sound system\* \$125
  - build new Jr Hi School Bldg\* \$6,800
