

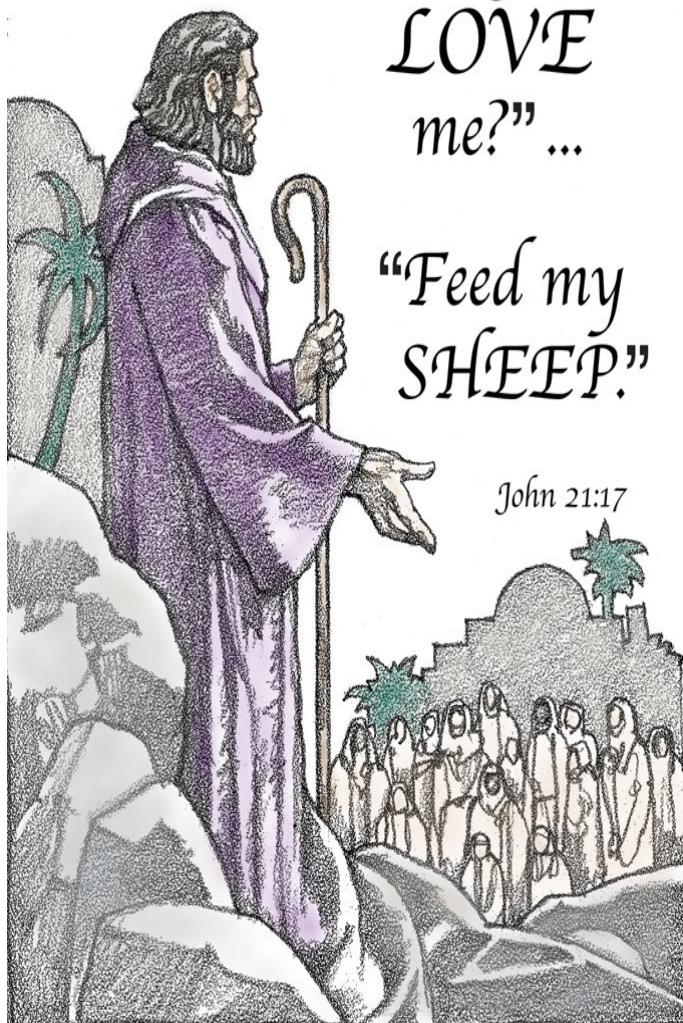

The Pastor's Corner

My dear Parishioners,

Something you notice when you enter the church during this glorious Easter season is the large, beautifully decorated Paschal Candle lighted and standing near the altar. It is used throughout the year at baptisms and funerals as a striking reminder that Christ, the Light of the world, is with us as Christians from the beginning to the end of our life's journey. But it is also lighted for every liturgy we celebrate during these fifty days between Easter and Pentecost. Why? There are several good reasons; among them, as a reminder of the presence of the Risen One among us but also as a reminder to each of us that we share in his light through our vocation as his disciples. Recall that, at our baptism, we are presented with a candle lighted from the Paschal Candle as we are instructed to keep the light of faith burning brightly throughout our entire life. In other words, as we move through the Easter season, we should dwell on the fact that, as people of the Light, we share in the life of the Risen Christ even now. What is more, we are challenged to share that Light with others that they might see Christ more clearly in and through us.

Yes, the Paschal Candle stands as a reminder that we have a mission to carry out as ambassadors of Christ. As he shares his Light with us, we must in turn share that same Light with our world. Stimulated by the inspired Words of today's Scriptures, let us ask ourselves how well are we letting "this little light of mine" shine in our world!

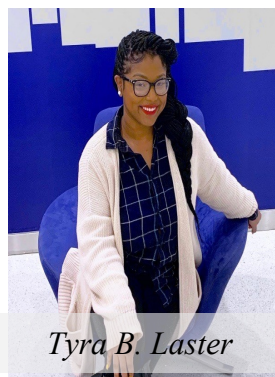
