

Lazarus is one my two favorite stories from the Gospels. This story is the first scripture I deliberately memorized. The first time I read the Raising of Lazarus it was as if I was reading the story of my life.

Time and time again I have found myself dead, bound, rotting and in a tomb behind a stone that I couldn't move even if I tried. Sometimes I didn't even realize it until I have one of those moments that we all have from time to time. One of those moments where in the darkness of our distance from the Lord we hear him weeping and all of a sudden we see our wretched state. We know where we are and we hope and pray that God will roll away this stone, unbind us and restore us to the life of relationship with Him.

We all find ourselves in the tomb from time to time. It could be from sin, it could be from indifference, doubt, or any manner of darkness. You will find yourself in that tomb and you will see the stone roll away. My prayer is that when the Lord says, "Come forth!" you will rise and come out and embrace the wonderful life our Lord has called you to.

Pour out your Spirit, so that I might be strengthened to go forth and witness to the Gospel in my everyday life through my words and actions.


In moments of hesitation, remind me:



The hard part of all this is that the other pillar of unity cannot be forced. The other pillar of building Christian community is a common goal: Holiness. Unity is actually a gift from God and it exists amongst the people who are striving for holiness. When we cooperate with Jesus' call on our lives He brings us into intimacy with other Christians. It is the intimacy that comes from true communion.

When the natural cooperates with the spiritual we can build true Christian community that proclaims the Gospel to the world. Strive for holiness and join those who are striving with you. This is how we build unity in the Church.
