Seven-Day Pro-Life Prayer: You are encouraged to pick up one of the prayer cards at the end of the pews. This Tuesday we observe Jan. 22, the 46th Anniversary of the Roe v. Wade decision that legalized abortion in the US Norma McCorvey "Jane Roe" was the plaintiff (1971); unmarried, claimed rape (she later denied), 5 months pregnant. By the time the 1973 Supreme Court decision was made, she had given her daughter up for adoption.

In 1997 Norma became a born-again Christian, speaking out against abortion. In 2003 she filed a motion to overturn Roe v. Wade, which was denied by the Supreme Court in 2005. She died in an assisted living home in Texas at age 69 in Feb 2017.

It is estimated (some states fail to report) more than 55 million abortions have been performed in the US since 1973. 1.5% due to rape/incest; 85% unmarried; 50% under age of 24. At current rates, an est. one-fourth of US women will have an abortion by age 45. (Focus on the Family) Who was Wade? (District Attorney Henry Wade from Texas).

Regardless of this horrific decision and others (like the recent failure to stop the use of Oregon tax \$ for abortions), the Pro-Life community continues to pray daily for a change in the hearts and minds of society. Let us pray
