### **2020 PASTORAL COUNCIL NOMINATIONS**

This is the year in which new members to the Pastoral Council must be discerned. The parish community participates in this process by nominating individuals they believe would serve the parish well.

Here is the information you need to identify appropriate candidate(s) and cast a ballot.

Who may cast a ballot? All parishioners over the age of 18 are eligible to cast a nominating ballot. You may nominate more than one individual for service on the Council. You may also nominate yourself.

Who may serve on the Council? Pastoral Council members should be:

- participating member of the parish for at least one year.
- fully-initiated, practicing Catholic in good standing.
- · willing to serve.

Members serve for two years, and may serve up to three consecutive terms.

Who is NOT eligible for nomination? Those people who are <u>already serving</u> on the Pastoral or Administrative Council, or whose term limits have been reached, may not be nominated.
