Live the Gospel of Life

Excerpted from a USCCB Reflection for Respect Life month

Twenty-five years ago, Pope St. John Paul II wrote that the Gospel of life is at the *heart* of Jesus' saving message to the world (*Evangelium vitae* 1). In taking on human flesh, dwelling among us, and sacrificing his very life for our redemption, Christ reveals the profound dignity of every human person.

Let us, then, reflect on how we personally live out the Gospel of Life:

Do I talk about and act towards others as I would talk about and treat Jesus himself?

Do I inform myself of the Church's teachings and engage in the civic arena as first a follower of Christ?

Do I support and advocate for laws and policies that protect and defend human life?

Do I help pregnant and parenting mothers in need?

Am I ready to support a loved one nearing death?

Through the intercession of Our Lady of Guadalupe, may Our Lord grant us the grace to truly and courageously live his Gospel of life!

Whether you are a 'card-carrying member' of a particular parish, go back and forth between more than one church, or attend different Masses at any variety of locations, stewardship is something to think about seriously.

Making an intentional decision about how to give, how much to give, and where, is probably the single most important factor in being a 'good steward'.

Another, more practical, consideration, is whether you wish to be able to write off your donations on your tax return. If you do, you need to be giving in an identifiable way so a contribution statement can be provided to you.

The best tool for parish giving is probably using **ONLINE GIVING**. You can sign up for this through the parish website. You will be able to view details about the various 'funds' and customize your donations, such as for Offertory (weekly), Renovation (monthly), Poor & Needy (quarterly), Altar Society (annual), etc. You can also set up a donation to any of the various Bishop's collections. **Once you have set up your donation schedule, you are done for the year.** Of course, you can go in and adjust it any time if you need to.

Another popular giving tool is **OFFERTORY ENVELOPES**. This is a subscription service which you can request by contacting the parish office. You will receive a packet of personalized, color-coded envelopes every couple of months for each of the collections shown above. If you attend regularly, like visual tools, and want to physically put something in the offering basket, then envelopes would be a good choice to consider.

Giving by loose **CHECK** is another intentional method of parish stewardship, and we can provide a contribution statement for these donations. It is important to make a note in the memo line if the check is for anything other than the regular weekly offertory (such as for the renovation fund or another second collection).

We encourage you to pray about your financial support of the church this year, and take steps to make your giving an intentional action of stewardship!


