

Speak Up!

As Oregon pro-life Catholics, it is our job to be the voice for the most vulnerable in our communities. Our legislators serve to further our voices within the Capitol. Although we sit in a difficult position with a pro-choice supermajority in Oregon, we need to make the pro-life message heard.

This year, Oregon Right to Life is introducing two important pieces of pro-life legislation:

Born Alive Infant Protection (SB 586 & HB 2699) — requires medical care be given to a baby that survives a failed abortion.

Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection (SB 671 & HB 2540) — prevents abortion after 20 weeks gestation, when medical professionals agree an unborn baby feels pain.

Both are modeled on federal legislation and laws that have been passed in other states. Over 75% of all Oregonians support giving medical care to babies that survive a failed abortion. Here in Veneta/Elmira:.
