WHY DO WE DO THAT?

CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Question: If a **person is dying** and **wants the last rites**, may a **layperson** say a **prayer** and have it be the same?

Answer: While a layperson could say prayers and bring Communion to someone at the point of death, a layperson cannot validly administer the last rites. The last rites involve anointing with holy oil and the absolution of sins, and only a validly ordained priest can administer that sacrament.
